



Description of Refraction and Contact Lens Services

It is important to have your vision and the health of your eyes examined by a licensed professional each year. The type of exam(s) you require depends on what type of vision correction you want to have.

If you want to obtain a prescription for eyeglasses, you will need to schedule a REFRACTION. Refraction determines whether or not a person needs eyeglasses. If you do not have insurance, the cost of this exam is \$100. If you have insurance, this exam may be covered in whole or in part. In that case, the front desk receptionists will confirm what is owed. Once your refraction is completed, you will be transitioned to our optical department to fill your new eyeglass prescription and learn what promotions are available.

If you want to obtain a prescription for contact lenses, you will need to schedule a CONTACT LENS FITTING. Contact lenses are medical devices that need to be fit according to the size and shape of your eyes by an eye care professional. If you do not have insurance, the cost of this exam is \$175*.

*The cost of the contact lens fitting may be higher if the eye care professional determines that specialty lenses are required. In the event that a specialty lens exam is required, we will inform you before moving forward with the exam. We will explain the process and help you obtain insurance coverage if possible.

The cost of this fitting exam does not cover any part of your contact lens order. The cost of your order depends on a variety of factors and will be discussed after your contact lens prescription is finalized.

During the contact lens fitting exam your doctor will:

- Evaluate the fit of your current lenses **or** the new lens prescribed based on your lifestyle and habits
- Arrange for “Insertion and Removal training” for new wearers or “refresher training” for current wearers, as necessary.
- Arrange for required follow-up appointments
- Dispense a finalized contact lens prescription and transition you to the contact lens consultant

When the doctor requests that you schedule a follow up visit, it is important that you make this a priority. The doctor remains available to make adjustments to your contact lens prescription for 3 months from the initial fitting exam. After that time, a \$50 evaluation fee will be charged for any adjustment you request. If you have any questions about this disclosure please feel free to ask them.
