C&C Millwright Takes the Title Again in 2025 Boys & Girls Club Celebrity Golf Classic

C&C Millwright blistered the golf course at Link Hills Country Club on June 13, 2025 to claim its second straight Bob Kesling Boys & Girls Club Celebrity Golf Classic by tying a tournament record score of 51 to take the title. The 22nd annual event had a field of 140 golfers that included many current and former college and professional athletes playing with local teams of 4 in the event.

The C&C Millwright team was lead by current Carson Newman Quarterback Zane Whitson along with Matt Dibella, Hunter Hartman Zack Lane, and Zane Potter. This was the second straight title for the team. Three shots back with a 54 was Petro Services comprised of Brian Foster, Scott Honeycutt, Randy Lindsay, Eric Thomason and former Tennessee Volunteer and NFL cornerback Malik Foreman. First Horizon was a shot back in third with a 55 from Larry Landers, Heath Pruitt, Kamryn Renner, Kylee Renner and Matt Renner.

The Greeneville Water Commission took the first Flight honors with a 62 in a scorecard playoff behind Delana DeBusk, Grace Hayes, Lanny Johnston, Will Tittle and former Tennessee Volunteer Football Player Tony Wilhoit. Heritage Community Bank, also with a 62, behind Carson Newman basketball player Jack Browder, Justin Burns, Brett St Clair, Will Melton and Allen Tolliver lost in the scorecard playoff.

In the individual contests held during the tournament the following were closest to the hole winners including Jack Browder on # 3, Mark Ross on #6, Zane Whitson on # 14 and Joe Thompson on # 16. Mike Cochran was the long drive contest winner. The tournament participants had a chance to win \$15,000 cash for a hole in One on #6 sponsored by State Representative David Hawk and Shaw & Shuffler Excavating

Many former Tennessee Volunteers football players participated in the event including former Washington Redskin NFL All-Pro Eddie Brown, Jeff Olszewski, Tim Priest, Bobby Scott, Wayne Spain, Danny Spradlin, Joe Thompson, Jani Trupovnieks, Dewey Warren, and Tony Wilhoit. Former Tennessee Vols basketball guard Jon Higgins,

former Middle Tennessee State University basketball standout Courtney Whitson, and Greeneville native and former women's professional basketball player Pam Kilday. Tusculum University Volleyball Coach Alberto Chiaparini and NHRA Pro Stock World Championship driver Allen Johnson also participated in the activities for the 22nd annual event.

Kesling stated, "It is a great honor to be involved in an organization such as the Boys & Girls Club." Bob Stated that living in Knoxville he has seen what an impact Boys & Girls Club's make on a community's youth. "I hope that from our tournament we can provide some additional funding for this great organization for the youth of Greeneville & Greene County," added Kesling.
