5 DAYS * 7 MEALS Enjoy the charm and hospitality of the Old South on this Spring excursion to Charleston and Savannah. The cobblestone streets of Charleston invite a stroll past colonial and antebellum mansions with gardens of fragrant magnolia and hibiscus. Explore the charming city aboard a horse drawn carriage and take a cruise to Fort Sumter where the first shots of the Civil War were fired. Visit Middleton Place where gardens are brimming over with Springs brightest blossoms. See Savannah's sights aboard a narrated open air trolley tour and enjoy fine cuisine at the historic Pirates House. Come along and experience the warmth and charm of the historic south on this tour as refreshing as a glass of sweet tea.

Day 1 - Sunday - April 12 Arrive in Charleston

Welcome aboard our coach as we begin our five-day Springtime in the South tour. We travel to historic Charleston, a cultured and refined city, and a beautifully preserved treasure. Spend two nights just minutes away from the historic district

Day 2 - Monday - April 13 Carriage Ride / Fort Sumter

Charleston is steeped in history and is known as one of the country's most important seaport towns. Step aboard a horse drawn carriage tour to experience the historic district in classic style. Glide along charming streets, admiring antebellum mansions, picturesque gardens, and historic churches. Our knowledgeable guide shares fascinating stories of the city's past. After spending free time at the city market we will board the ferry enjoying harbor views on our way to Fort Sumter. Explore this fort where America's deadliest war began in 1861. Enjoy an included dinner this evening. (CB,D)

Day 3 - Tuesday - April 14 Middleton Place/ Travel to Savannah

This morning we step back in time as we visit Middleton Place, home of America's oldest landscaped gardens. Acres of stunning formal gardens are truly a sight

to behold! Enjoy a house tour of this estate that has remained under the stewardship of the same family for years, and view a historic stable yard with heritage animal breeds. Lunch is included before departing for Savannah with its monuments, museums, and moss laden trees. Accommodations await in the downtown historic district for a two-night stay. (CB,L)

Day 4 - Wednesday - April 15 Savannah Trolley Ride / Mansion Tour Pirates House Dinner

Savannah - the Belle of the South - dates back over 270 years. Our morning trolley tour takes us past historic attractions like the Juliette Gordon Lowe House, the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist, the Cotton exchange and the historic Riverfront. We'll visit one of the homes on the National Register of Historic Places telling a unique story of an era defined by elegance and whimsey. Following lunch on our own we travel to the fishing village of Pin Point where an old oyster and crab factory sits along the marshes of the Moon River. We'll learn about oyster harvesting and shelling, and the life cycle of the blue crab - a staple food in this area. Returning to Savannah we'll enjoy some free time along the riverfront before our dinner at the historic Pirates House. (CB,D)

Day 5 - Thursday - April 16 Travel Home

We return home today with fond memories of our Southern journey. (CB)
