## **Treasurers Report**

The Bantry Hospice Project is a Limited Company. The audited accounts annually and the AGM was held on December 14th 2011 in the Westlodge Hotel, and this meeting was open to the public to attend. While the Palliative Care Unit is open since February 2010 and is fully paid for, our aim now is to give the palliative care team our full support in maintaining the excellent service they provide here in West Cork.

A contribution of €10,000 was made available to meet some of the costs of providing and maintaining the services of a Social Worker, equipment costing

€7,500 was purchased for the unit and also special chairs provided for patients who are looked after in their own homes.

Financial support is provided for staff training and also to cover the cost of Night Nurse Staff when needed

Without the generosity of the people of Bantry and the surrounding areas the Bantry Hospice project would not be able to support this very important and necessary service.
