



Our learning

November has positively flown by. The children really embraced our story 'Peace At Last' and it was lovely that so many of you were able to support us with the shared toothbrushing and bedtime story time that accompanied this topic. The children love it when their grown-ups come in and share activities with them at Chestnut.

Although the weather has at times been challenging in November it hasn't stopped us from getting outside. Last month saw a new delivery of saplings from The Woodland Trust. The children have been very busy helping to plant them around the Apple Garden to create new hedging that will provide both a screen and a new habitat for wildlife. We look forward to watching our saplings grow. We have marked them with bright ribbons so they don't get accidentally trodden on during play.



As well as a delivery of saplings we also had a delivery of worms and now have our very own worm farm. The worm farm will be an extra asset to our garden and we hope the worms will reward us by turning some of our food waste into liquid fertiliser for our flower beds. The children have enjoyed feeding their fruit and vegetable scraps to the worms and looking at them wriggle and move about.



A big thank you to our parent who joined us for Gardening Club in November, we really value support from our parents to help us attend to jobs in the garden. We planted some garlic bulbs and flower bulbs and look forward to watching them all come up in the spring time. Who knows, maybe we will even be able to use our garlic in future cooking projects.



Over the next few weeks the children will be reading the story of Goldilocks and in December we will also be thinking about the tradition of Christmas. If your child will turn 5 years old between 1st September 2026 and 31st August 2027 you now need to apply for a school place. School applications can be made online at <https://www.devon.gov.uk/children-families-education/education/school-admissions/>

In April 2026 you will then be notified about which school has been allocated for your child. Let us know which school your child will be attending as we will spend time liaising with their new setting in the summer term to ensure a smooth transition.
