Weekend Backpack Program Begins a New School Year

St. Paul Ministry of Charity ensures that children have food in their homes over the reekend when free school lunches are not available. Since 2011 our church family and many ommunity organizations have supported this project. Students from Tell City, Cannelton, and erry Central are able to participate if they qualify. Last year over 90 kilowere included in the rogram. Over 3200 individual bags of food were purchased and distributed to the schools for hose most in need. We paid Tri State Food Bank \$23,694.30 for the cost of the bags and elivery charges. Each bag contained 4 entrees, 4 fruit cups, 2 cereals, 2 juices, 2 milks, and 2 nacks.

As with most grocery prices, food costs continue to rise. The last school year began with the cost of each bag at \$6.25. Next month was \$6.75. Then 3 months later it was \$7.91 per bag. This year, we hope things won't increase at the same rate. The estimated cost of this year is \$290 per child, without any price hikes.

Funding comes from many sources. St. Paul parishioners, St. Ann's Society from St. Michael's Church, St. Mark Catholic Church, First Baptist Church Mission Team, Emmanuel Lutheran Church, Ladies Lenten Breakfast, Knights of Columbus, Kiwanis, Delta Kappa Gamma, Mu Gamma, Edgar and Roberts Mulzer Poundation, an emergency donation from Perry County Community Foundation, and a grant from United Way of Perry County helped fund our cost for this past year.

Each month many volunteers donate manpower and gasoline costs to load and deliver bags to schools in Tell City, Cannelton, and Perry Central. Without Denny Graves, Danny Tapley, Bruce Chinn, Jim Tyler, Brian Herwig, and Steve Owen this would not have been possible. Of course, school personnel from 4 schools, Heather Massey, Joyce Foury, Amanda Evans, and Vanessa Ford, take care of signing up students, ordering, and delivering bags to students each Friday. St. Paul's office staff, Mandy Bauer, Tammy Brunner, and Katle Rothgerber offer lots of assistance as well.

We ask for your continued support through prayers and/or financial help as we start our 15th year of this ministry to the children in our county who come from food insecure homes. You can use your Sunday offering envelopes or drop off donations at the church office. No amount is too small to help with our mission to serve those most in need. Thanks for making Perry County a better place for all who live here.




