FASTING & ABSTINENCE GUIDELINES

Every person 14 years of age or older should abstain from eating meat (and items made with meat) on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and every Friday during Lent. Persons 18 through 59 years of age, health permitting, should fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting consists of one full meal per day, with two smaller meals that do not add up to a full meal, and no snacks.

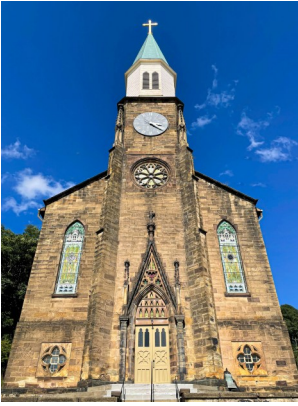

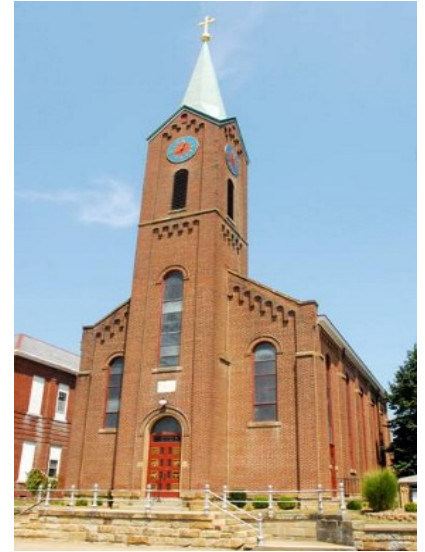
