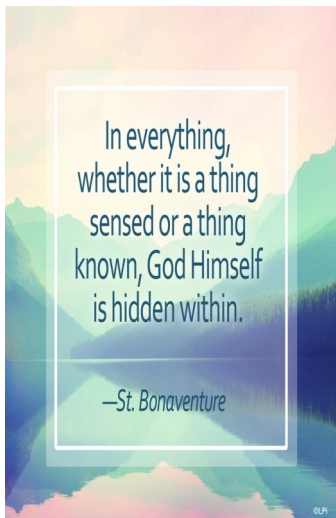

She worked at a Benedictine Sisters' run foster home, on a Maryknoll project on Media Awareness, and on an ecumenical team in an education & counseling center for Korean women in relationships with US soldiers stationed on nearby bases. After Bonny returned to the states, she taught with the local community college on the Fort Campbell army installation. In her local parish in Cadiz, KY she & her husband work with OCIA, Stewardship, small faith community groups, & church ministry. She has taught English conversation for the past 2 summers in Egypt at a Coptic Catholic seminary, a project first begun by a Maryknoll priest 20+ years ago.

Bonny will speak at St. Michael and St. Pius V during the weekend of July 19, 2026 to share her mission experience as part of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis Missionary Cooperation Plan 2026. The second collection will be taken to support Maryknoll Lay Missioners. Your kind welcome and generous support is most appreciated.
