



STAY ABOARD APPLICATION

Bylaw 30 of the Cullen Bay Marina Act states that vessel Owners/Crew may stay overnight on vessels on a casual basis for two days in any seven-day period without obtaining permission.

The Marina Management may permit bonafide Owners/Crew of transiting vessels to stay aboard their vessels for up to one month subject to their agreement to the following conditions:

- 1) Only visiting vessels (vessels with a home port not in Darwin) may apply for stay aboard status for a period of up to one calendar month.
 - 2) All toilets of vessels must be bagged prior to entry into the Marina unless holding tanks are fitted. Holding tanks **MUST NOT** be discharged into the Marina.
 - 3) Vessels moored at private residences must make arrangements with the lessee of the berth regarding bathroom facilities.
 - 4) Wherever possible, stay aboard vessels should moor stern-in.
 - 5) No domestic pets will be allowed to reside in the Marina (unless a Registered Assistance Animal).
 - 6) At the end of one month, vessels wishing to extend stay aboard must apply to the CEO for an extension. This may be granted at the discretion of the CEO only in exceptional circumstances.
