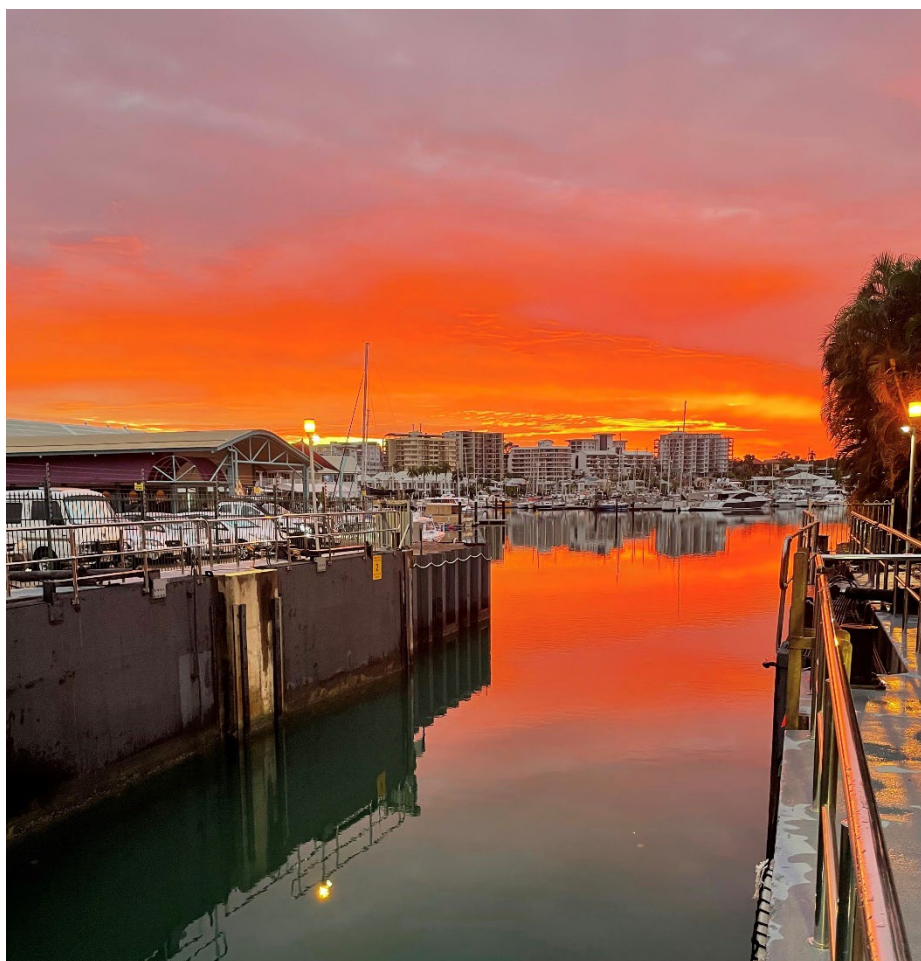

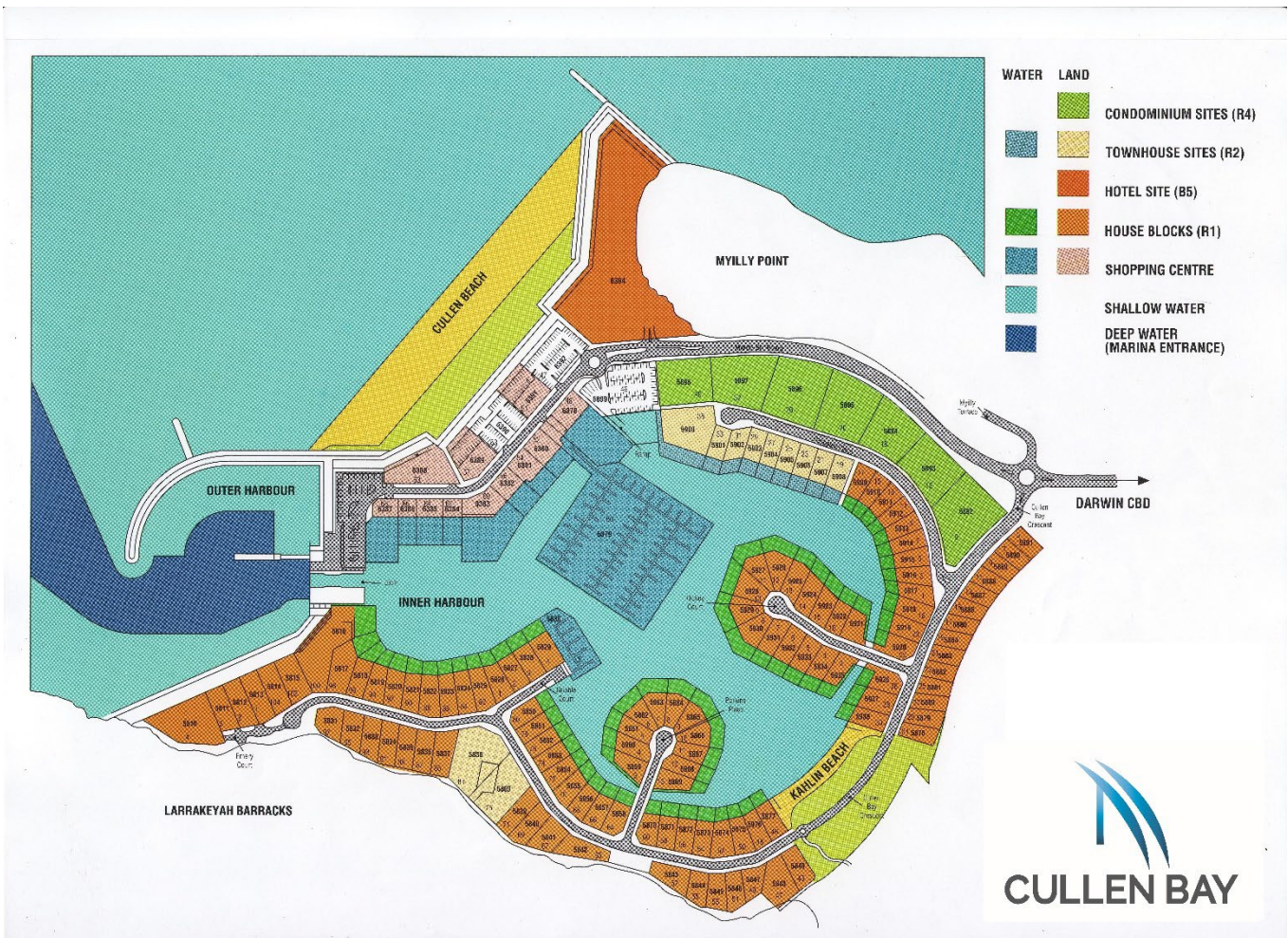

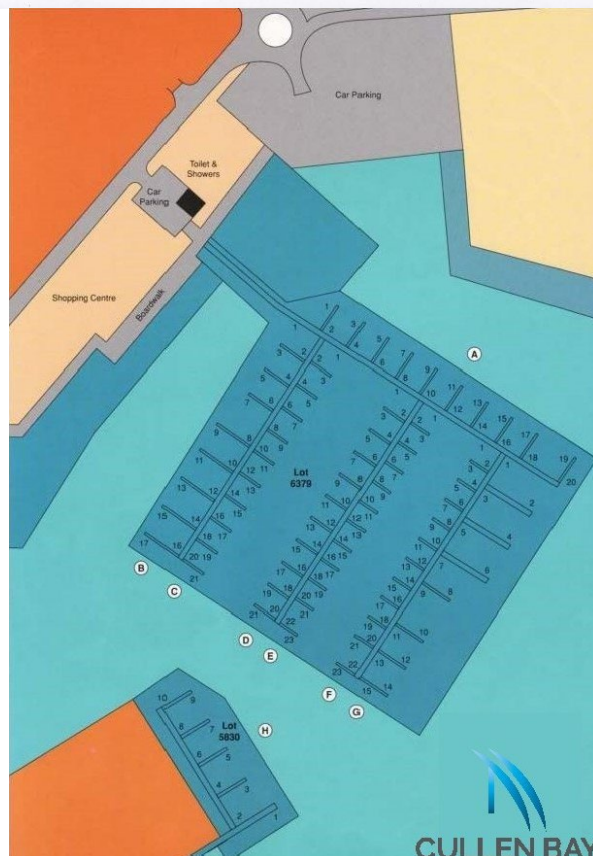

Marina Facilities & Information

The relaxed, tropical, beachside lifestyle of Cullen Bay, less than 2 km from Darwin's cosmopolitan CBD, makes it a highly desirable Top End destination for holidaymakers and seafarers.

The Marina, flanked by some of the best restaurants that Darwin has to offer and fringed by Darwin's premium residential suburb of Cullen Bay, is the magnificent home to over 250 vessels, providing modern facilities for local and visiting vessels and 24-hour Staffing making it the safest and best Marina Precinct in the Northern Territory.

Marina Toilets & Showers are located at the top of the Marina entrance walkway. H Jetty does not have access to these.

Public & Disabled Toilets are located in the main beachside carpark.

Public Pay Phone is located at the Ferry Terminal next to the Lock.

Rubbish Skip bin is just behind the Marina toilets.

Fuel Diesel and Unleaded Petrol pumps are located on the Ferry Jetty outside the Lock. This self-serve facility takes both Debit and Credit Cards that are authorized by a pin.

Marina Office Hours Monday to Friday, 9:00am – 5:00pm. The Office is closed weekends and Public Holidays.

Lock Opening Hours on the hour upon request between **6:00am - 11:00pm** every day. It is manned around the clock for emergencies.

Free Car Parking There are 2 x Public Car Parks, one each side of the road at the roundabout entry to the Marina Precinct and another one is found beachside, mid-way through the Precinct.

Laundry In the passageway between **Exotic North Indian** and **Yots** restaurants is the dry cleaning, washing and self-service laundrette **Baywash**. They can handle all your washing needs.



Gym & Fitness Rich Life Health & Fitness boutique gym is across the road from the Marina. Everything you need for a workout, they also run classes and hold beachside Yoga and Pilates classes in dry season.

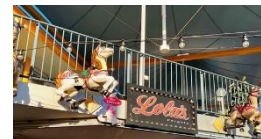
Haul Out Facilities are located next to the boat-ramp. Services available are antifouling, polishing, skin-fittings and out of water condition reports. Currently only for monohulls up to 26T and 45FT.



Cullen Bay Restaurants & Bars

There are a variety of fantastic restaurants along the boardwalk and in the Precinct. Each offers amazing food so be sure to try them all. Starting on the Boardwalk and back along the beachside:

Lola's At the Marina entrance. The quirky décor and waterfront views make it perfect for chilling with a cocktail or a pint from their selection of tap beers, along with music and a selection of pub food.



Soul Essence on the Bay Tastes of the Territory and share meals enhanced with native Australian flavours. They are passionately committed to offering the freshest, seasonal, locally sourced ingredients to create a contemporary menu.



Exotic North Indian Cuisine Their focus is on delivering authentic Punjabi and North Indian cuisine prepared with locally sourced, fresh produce for a taste of India in Darwin.



Yots Greek Taverna Modern and traditional Greek cuisine with fresh seafood is their specialty. The dining experience boasts daily fresh vegetables, fruit, fish, oysters and other delicious seafood.



Boatshed Coffee House and Café With both inside airconditioned tables and waterfront boardwalk dining, the Boatshed even has a playroom for the kids so you can sit back and savour your food knowing they are entertained.



Cathy's Place Specialising in mud crab and chilli mud crab, Cathy's has a beautiful private deck for dining overlooking the water. Bookings are essential.



Eat a Pizza Across the road from the Marina is a wonderful garden strung with fairy lights. The extensive menu of pizzas and Italian dishes are a "Taste of Italy" in Cullen Bay.

General Information

Grocery Shopping Cullen Bay Mart convenience store in the Marina Precinct is open 24/7. Coles and Woolworths large supermarkets are in town and offer online shopping and delivery services. Halfway to town, closer to the Marina, is a small IGA store for basics.

Mobile Phone Service The main mobile phone service is Telstra, with Optus the second biggest. Sim cards are available directly from the Telstra shop in the CBD and also from supermarkets. Australia has large areas in the outback with poor or no reception, so check coverage if you plan to travel inland.

WiFi The Marina Precinct does not have a public wifi. 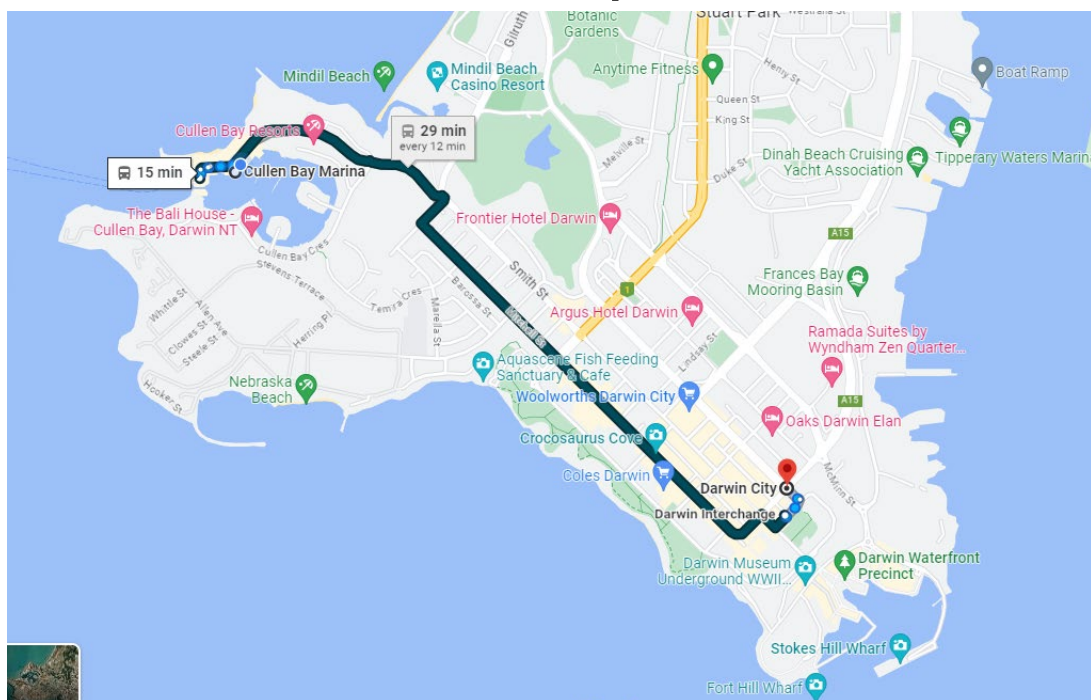

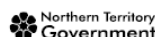

Beam Electric Scooters An alternative and fun way to get around town. All you need to do is download the Beam App and you are away. There are pick-up/drop-off points around the Marina.



Car Hire There are a number of car hire operators in town. Apart from the international companies there are some "budget" ones such as: Bargain, NT Car Rentals and JJ's.

Taxi Taxis are frequent and easy to find all around Darwin and cost about the same as an Uber. Call **13Cabs** or **131 008**

Uber Is widely used in and around Darwin and is a quick and cheap way to get around in comfort.

Pharmacies (Chemists) There are a couple of large Chemistwarehouse drugstores in town near the supermarkets. They range a good selection of personal hygiene and beauty items as well as medicines and prescription dispensing. The other main Chemist, on a smaller scale, is Blooms.

Out & About



Cullen Bay Beach is one of the most beautiful locations in Darwin. The manicured lawns (popular for weddings!) are the best place to relax and enjoy the magnificent sunsets. Take a rug or chair and enjoy the evening breeze and view. Friday, Saturday & Sunday, April – September, we have a variety of great Foodtrucks onsite so dinner is ready-made, or pick some up from one of our restaurants.

Mindil Beach Casino is only 1.6km away on Gilruth Avenue, a 3-minute drive or a 10 minute walk. Enjoy an ice-cold beverage, some entertainment, or a delicious meal at one of the restaurants. The **Infinity Pool & Beats Bar**, open Thursday – Sunday afternoons to the public, is the perfect place to sip on cocktails whilst lazing by, or in, the pool, against a background of chilled sounds from the resident DJ.

George Brown Botanic Gardens 4Km away (7minute drive) the gardens cover 42 hectares and are noted for their collection of Northern Australian and tropical plant species. Why not check them out, it's free of charge! **Eva's**, their lovely garden café is a must for breakfast, lunch, coffee or a drink.

Mindil Beach Sunset Markets a 15 minute walk from Cullen Bay. Held on Thursdays & Sundays, April – October, browse for handmade crafts, art, and jewellery, enjoy live entertainment, and pop down to the beach for another stunning sunset. Experience the taste of five different continents from the many Foodtrucks onsite.

Parap Markets, very popular with the locals, are on Saturday mornings. Parap is approx 4,5km away and can be reached by bus. There are heaps of food stalls as well as plenty of arts and crafts. Often some live music is played. Well worth a visit. Parap bakery has a great selection of pastries too!

Museum & Art Gallery of Northern Territory displays a mix of Aboriginal and more recent history and modern development. Free of charge, it features a fascinating and realistic exhibition of cyclone Tracy. The Museum is only 4km away (5minute drive). Saltwater, the garden café and its view over the water is great for breakfast or lunch.

Swimming Pools Darwin has a number of open-air swimming options. Parap Pool, 4,5km away has a 50m Olympic pool, a 25m pool and a water playground. Nightcliff Pool, 11.5km away and beachside, has a 50m pool, a kiddies pool and a great café right next door. The pools both run aquatic classes. Darwin Waterfront large lagoon pool is free, offering safe seawater swimming and also a wave pool which charges an entrance fee.

Lawn Bowls For a little gentle exercise, maybe with a couple of beverages to keep cool (so Darwinish!) and plenty of shade, just up the road past Mindil Beach is Darwin Lawn Bowls Club. They have a bistro and bar and run a fun Trivia night on Wednesdays with prizes.

Tennis Gardens Tennis Club welcomes visitors so if you're feeling active book yourself a court. As with everything in Darwin, the club is close by, well within walking distance or a short scooter ride away, just past Mindil Beach Casino.

Yacht Club/Darwin Sailing Club 5km away in Fannie Bay. Based on the waterfront, naturally, the Sailing Club is a great social venue to catch up with yachties and non. Enjoy a meal and a drink whilst watching the boats and of course, another wonderful Darwin sunset.

Darwin Trailer Boat Club Right next to the Sailing Club, a smaller version, again with awesome views, food and drinks.
