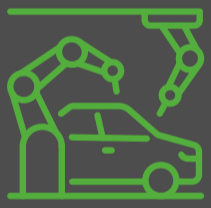

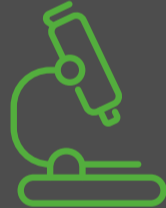
- **Renewables Obligation (RO)**

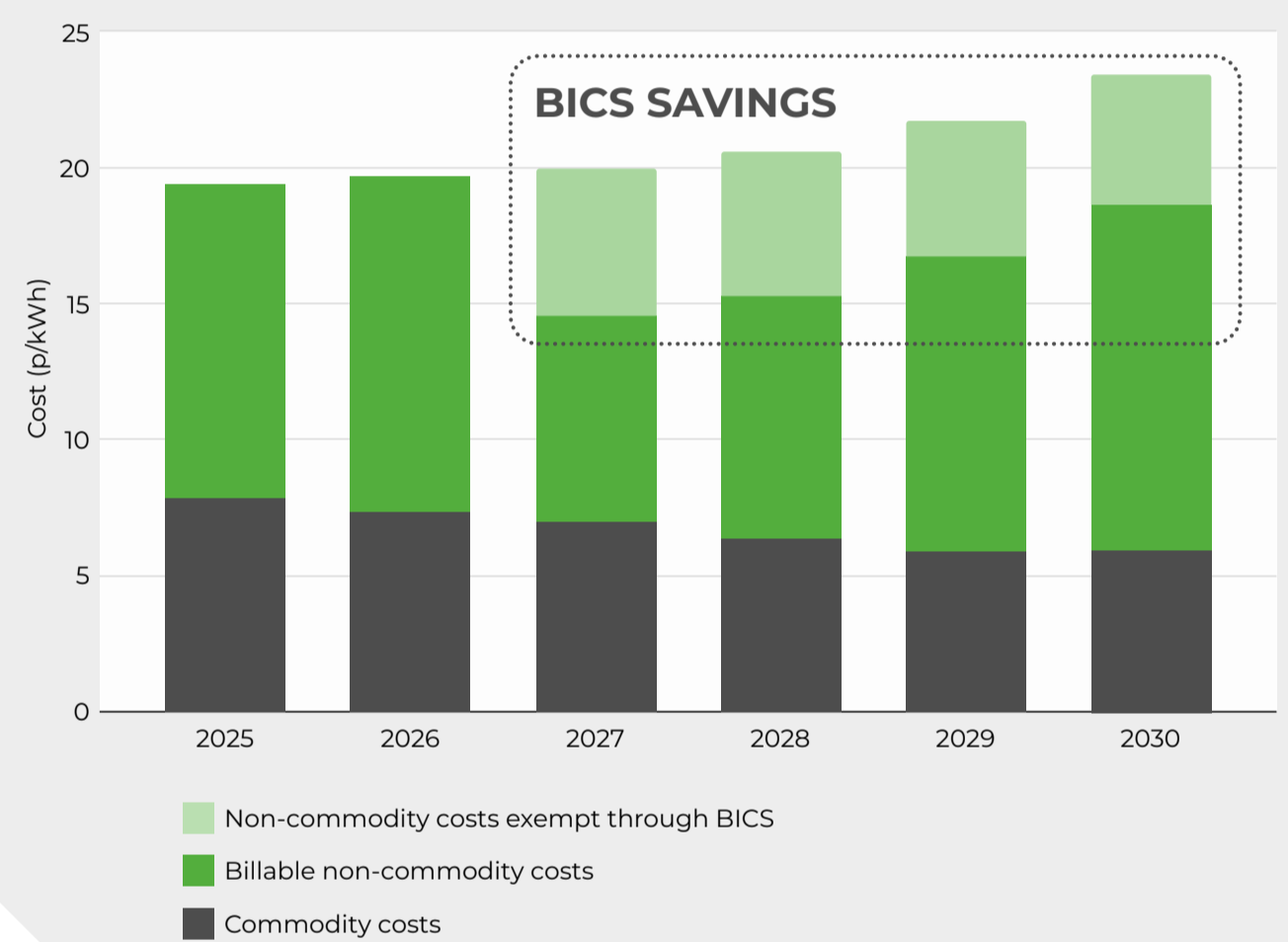
