



Upper School Supply List

\$35 Classroom Maintenance Fee

Charged to FACTS 7th-12th grade students.

This one-time fee provides classroom-related supplies such as disinfectant wipes, paper towels, Kleenex, hand sanitizer, and expo markers.

General Supplies Needed (every class throughout the year)

- Weekly Planner
 - Needs to be big enough to keep track of homework assignments. In the Upper School, students are responsible for writing down & keeping track of all their daily assignments from teachers.
- College Rule Loose Leaf Paper (recommended 1 pack per binder to start out)
- Binders (You will NOT need one for every class. It is always a good idea to combine the 2-3 classes that fall sequentially during their daily schedule into ONE larger binder, like a 1 ½ inch binder)
- Pens (Black or Blue AND Red)
- Highlighters
- Pencils (#2)
- 24 Pack Colored Pencils
- 8th-12th Grades: TI-84-CE* (if you have TI-84, you do not need to buy CE version)

NOTE: These are GENERAL school supplies that will be needed throughout the year and should be replenished on an as-needed basis. Items may be stored in the student's assigned locker.

SPECIFIC class-related school supplies will be requested by the individual class teachers. These may include index cards, composition books, dividers, graph paper, etc. These lists will be available the first day of school (OR during the Meet the Teacher time prior to the start of school) from each of their teachers.

MS Locker dimensions are: 34 in. Height x 12 in. Wide (across) x 11 in. Deep

- Students may decorate the inside of their locker however they would like. Magnets work best for putting things up.
- A standard locker shelf is helpful to give you two levels of storage.
- You do not need to purchase a lock because the lock is already on it. You will receive your locker number AND combination whenever you get your class schedule (First day of school or Meet the Teacher time prior to start of school)

*TI-84-CE (CE model graphs in color). Used or New. All students are required to have a TI-84- CE or TI-84 calculator throughout upper school and will use the calculator for ACT testing.
