Reader 2: (*light the next shortest purple candle*)

Reader 1: And now we remember how the angels told the shepherds news of great joy.

Reader 2: God’s beloved was born among us, so that we could all have joy deep in our hearts.

Reader 1: This joy is deeper than sorrow, stronger than fear. This joy surprises us even on the coldest, darkest winter day.

Reader 2: We light a candle for joy. May joy shine bright in our hearts and in every human heart. (*light the pink candle*)

Sometimes we feel lonely.

But your joy runs deeper than our every sorrow.
