# From the Desk of Fr. Kingsley

#### CALLED TO SPREAD HOPE: WORLD MISSION SUNDAY 2025

World Mission Sunday is a sacred occasion, an International Day of Prayer and solidarity with the Church's missionary efforts worldwide. It is a celebration that unites Catholics everywhere into one universal community of faith. On this day, we renew our baptismal call to be missionary disciples through fervent prayer, active participation in the Eucharist, and generous support of the annual collection for the Society for the Propagation of the Faith.

The theme for World Mission Sunday 2025, "Missionaries of Hope Among All Peoples," invites each of us, individually and collectively, to walk in the footsteps of Christ. We are called to be messengers of hope, bearers of love, and instruments of peace in a world longing for healing and grace.

#### **A Brief History**

The origins of World Mission Sunday can be traced back to Blessed Pauline Jaricot, a visionary laywoman of 19th-century France, who mobilized prayer and financial support for the Church's missionary outreach. In 1822, she founded a model of mission support that would eventually be embraced by the universal Church.

In 1926, Pope Pius XI formally established World Mission Sunday and designated the Society for the Propagation of the Faith as one of the Pontifical Mission Societies. Today, this annual celebration stands as a powerful sign of Catholic communion and global solidarity, coordinated by the very society Pauline inspired.

#### What Happens on World Mission Sunday?

On this special day, we join our Holy Father in supporting his missionary efforts around the world. It is the only global collection mandated by Canon Law (Canon 791.4), underscoring its importance in the life of the Church.

Through prayer and financial support, we extend the mercy of the Lord to vulnerable communities served by the Pope's missions. World Mission Sunday is a joyful affirmation of our shared identity as missionaries by virtue of our baptism. It offers each of us a chance to sustain the Church's life-giving presence among the poor, the forgotten, and the marginalized.

#### **How Can You Help?**

Give generously to the World Mission Sunday collection. Share the message on social media to raise awareness. Speak with friends and family about the impact of their generosity. Pray for missionaries and those they serve, that they may be strengthened in faith and hope. Your support brings God's love, mercy, and peace to those most in need.

#### More Than a Collection

World Mission Sunday is not merely a second collection; it is the Church's annual invitation to place mission and evangelization at the heart of our lives and parish communities. It reminds us that every Catholic, by baptism, is a missionary disciple. Indeed, our own nation was once a mission territory, sustained by the very generosity we are now privileged to offer.

Through the Society for the Propagation of the Faith, your contributions support pastoral and catechetical programs, church construction, healthcare, and education in mission territories. Let us respond together with one heart and one spirit as missionaries of hope among all peoples.

#### A Universal Call

As members of the Catholic Church, which is universal by its very nature, we are invited to participate actively in this sacred mission. Our prayers and offerings on World Mission Sunday empower the Church's vital work of evangelization and proclaim the Gospel to every corner of the earth.

Let us unite in prayer for the success of missionary efforts and for all those who dedicate their lives to spreading the Good News. Your generosity is a radiant witness to the love and compassion that lie at the heart of our faith.




