

Construction Update



As Fr. Martin announced at Masses this weekend, the Bathroom Accessibility Project has been approved by the Chancery. Construction has begun.

Fr. Martin has noted that this project "is not a luxury item but a necessary addition to the church building and so essential." Additionally, "there will be some need for adjustments" as there will be impacts to our liturgies and usual operations.

Please be mindful and respect the construction fencing placed this morning - it is there for everyone's safety.

We anticipate the parish offices to be open as usual.

The following adjustments are effective immediately and until further notice:

- The west entrance to the church from the piazza is closed for entry and exit.
- The front church doors from 12th Street will be open ½ hour before scheduled confessions or Mass.
- These church doors will be secured ½ hour after Mass concludes.
