#### From the Treasurer

**July Year-to-Date** Revenues are \$11,200 over Budget. This is due to the sale of our plow truck, plow, and grasshopper lawn mower. Year-to-Date Expenses are \$27,500 less than Budget. This is primarily due to reduced Maintenance costs, as we have not yet spent any money for various items that were budgeted, or in some cases, we will not spend any at all. Here are some of the items that have not yet been expensed:

Clubhouse Enhancements - Very little needed - \$1,600 under budget

Grounds Beautification – Front Gate Delayed - \$4,100 under budget

Maintenance Supplies and Equip Repairs – Very little needed - \$6,300 under budget

Beaches & Lakes - Aerator Repairs Delayed - \$9,600 under budget

Septic Fields – Delayed – \$4,500 under budget

Fuel – No longer needed - \$1,900 under budget

Net Income for the YTD is currently at \$86,000. We should end up the year with a Net of \$59,000. This compares favorably to the \$30,500 Budget.

#### **Monthly Dues -**

I need to remind everyone, especially the new owners, that by rule, the office is not allowed to handle dues payments. There are two options to making payments. 1) Checks for dues should be sent by the owner, or by their bank, to PO Box 566. 2) Pay your dues through Zelle, if your bank supports it.

Dues are due on the FIRST day of the month. If you are paying for a month, within the month after the 1<sup>st</sup>, make sure you send them in at least a week before month end, otherwise they may be received late, and you will be assessed a \$40 late fee. The checks need to be in the hands of our accountant by the last day of the month. Better still, pay your dues in the month prior.

Zelle payments are instantaneous. I monitor the checking account daily, so I know when a payment is deposited, a day or two before the check clears. You will be credited on the received date. I can help anyone who wants to use Zelle. I will not see your bank account number; I only need an email address and a phone number. By using Zelle, you can set up payments automatically.

#### **Water Turn Off for the Season**

The park will be turning off water on the following dates: Oct. 4, Oct. 11, Oct 18, and Oct 25.

- The park will turn off the Buffalo Box and winterize the stem only. There is no cost for this.
- The park does NOT winterize your unit. You will have to either do it yourself or pay your own contractor to do this part.
- You must email dave@lvconstruction.com with the date that works for you, and you will be added to the spreadsheet.
- If you want to turn it off at the buffalo box yourself or with someone other than park staff, you will be required to email dave@lvconstruction to prove that it was turned off.

#### **Extended Water Usage**

- If you want to have continuous water usage or the ability to turn it on and off yourself, in your unit throughout the off-season (November 1<sup>st</sup> to March 31<sup>st</sup>) you are REQUIRED to fill out the Extended Water Usage Form available at the office or on the website.
- You will need to return this form and a \$250 flat fee to the office by November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025. This fee and rule is in the Willow Rules, Appendix A and will be enforced this offseason.
- If you do not have the park staff turn your water off or prove to park staff that you have it turned off, you may be sent a warning to turn in the Extended Water Usage Form and fee.

#### Helping Make it Happen: The Secretary's Report

It's August and here we are!! As we move through the month, we continue to move forward to improve the park.

Below are a few projects we are working on that I shared at the board meeting:

#### Web Design -

Good News! We have found a web designer that can work on our particular platform. We will be signing a contract with this firm and will be ready to update our website, making it more user friendly and better organize our information. We hope to eventually have forms that you can fill out and submit directly online, along with making information easier to find.

#### Warning and Fine Notices -

In response to feedback from our owners, we are working hard to be consistent in enforcing the rules at Willow Run. As a result, after having discussions with numerous owners, we have been issuing warning letters and eventually fines to residents who have been in continual violation of rules and regulations in the park. Although we are a group of four volunteers, we are doing our best to work with our owners to rectify these issues. As Connie has said, please know that we are listening to your concerns both in person, on your comment forms and in our Grievance Committee.

In the months of July and August, we have sent two fine letters and several warning letters, along with having many personal conversations with owners to help solve existing issues.

#### **Vacant Properties -**

This year there have been numerous sales and purchases of Willow Run properties. We have been receiving feedback from new and old owners that during the time that some properties have been vacant, items have been taken out of their yards, including plants and bushes being dug out of flower beds in the transition. Please, please understand that these properties and their contents still belong to an owner. Let's be respectful neighbors!

#### The Pool -

We continue to improve your experience at the pool. The umbrellas have been secured, so please leave them in the tables. We are also trying our best to keep the pool open on Saturdays and Sundays during September, with tentative hours 10:00 am - 6:00 pm. We are waiting to see if we have enough guards to complete the shifts. Fingers crossed! A reminder that if you have guests at the pool, please brief them on rules and acceptable behavior while they are there.


