DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. JOHN CHRYSOSTOM

(Letters and page numbers below refer to the sections in “The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity” found in the pews)

A: First Antiphon (pg. 18): Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

B: Second Antiphon (pg. 20): Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead; who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

C: Third Antiphon (pg. 24):

- During the Little Entrance, chant the Apolytikion of the Resurrection.

D: Entrance Hymn (pg. 25): Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead; who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

- After the Entrance, sing the hymns in the following order below.

E: Troparia (pg. 26):

Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 8 (pg. 102 in *The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity*): From the heights Thou didst descend, O compassionate One, and Thou didst submit to the three-day burial, that Thou might deliver us from passion; Thou art our life and our Resurrection, O Lord, glory to Thee.

Troparion of All Saints of North America – Tone 1 (pg. 26 in *The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity*)

F: Kontakion for Forgiveness Sunday – Tone 6: O Thou Who guidest to wisdom, and givest understanding and intelligence, the Instructor of the ignorant, and Helper of the poor, strengthen my heart and grant it understanding, O Master. Give me word, O Word of the Father; for behold, I shall not refrain my lips from crying to Thee, O merciful One, have mercy upon me who am fallen.
