DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. BASIL THE GREAT

(Letters and page numbers below refer to the sections in "The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity" found in the pews)

A: First Antiphon (pg. 18): Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

B: Second Antiphon (pg. 20): Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead; who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

C: Third Antiphon (pg. 24): During the Little Entrance, chant the Resurrectional Apolytikion.

D: Entrance Hymn (pg. 25): Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead; who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

• After the Entrance, sing the hymns in the following order below.

E: Troparia (pg. 26):

Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 4 (pg. 96 in *The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity*): Having learned the joyful message of the Resurrection from the angel the women disciples of the Lord cast from them their parental condemnation. And proudly broke the news to the Disciples, saying: Death hath been spoiled; Christ God is risen, granting the world Great Mercy.

Troparion for St. John Climacus – Tone 8: The barren wilderness thou didst make fertile with the streams of thy tears; and by thy deep sighing thou hast given fruit through thy struggles a hundredfold. Accordingly, thou hast become a star for the universe, sparkling with miracles. Therefore, O righteous Father John Climacus, intercede with Christ God to save our souls.

Troparion of All Saints of North America – Tone 1 (pg. 26 in The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity)

F: Kontakion for Lent – Tone 8: To thee, the Champion Leader, do I offer thanks of victory, O Theotokos, thou who hast delivered me from terror; but as thou that hast that power invincible, O Theotokos, thou alone can set me free: from all forms of danger free me and deliver me, that I may cry unto thee: Hail, O Bride without Bridegroom.
