#### DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. JOHN CHRYSOSTOM

(Letters and page numbers below refer to the sections in "The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity" found in the pews)

A: First Antiphon (pg. 18): Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

B: Second Antiphon (pg. 20): Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

**C:** Third Antiphon and Little Entrance (pg. 24): During the Little Entrance, chant the <u>Resurrectional Apolytikion</u>. The Eisodikon (Entrance Hymn) is "O come, let us worship... save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead..."

D: Entrance Hymn: Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

• *After the Little Entrance, sing these hymns in the following order:* 

#### E. Troparia:

- *Troparion of the Resurrection Tone 3:* Let the heavens rejoice and the earth be glad, for the Lord hath done a mighty act with His own arm. He hath trampled down death by death, and become the first-born from the dead. He hath delivered us from the depths of Hades, granting the world the Great Mercy.
- Troparion of the Forefeast of the Nativity Tone 4: Be thou ready, Bethlehem, Eden hath opened unto all. Ephratha, prepare thyself, for now, behold, the Tree of Life hath blossomed forth in the cave from the holy Virgin. Her womb hath proved a true spiritual Paradise, wherein the divine and saving Tree is found, and as we eat thereof we shall all live, and shall not die as did Adam. For Christ is born now to raise the image that had fallen aforetime.
- *Troparion of the Sunday before the Nativity Tone 2:* Great are the accomplishments of faith; for the three holy youths rejoiced in the fountain of flames as though at waters of rest. And the Prophet Daniel appeared a shepherd to the lions as though they were sheep. Wherefore, by their prayers, O Christ God, save our souls.
- Troparion of All Saints of North America

*F:* Kontakion of the Forefeast of the Nativity of Christ – Tone 1: On this day the Virgin cometh to the cave to give birth to God the Word ineffably, Who was before all the ages. Dance for joy, O earth, on hearing the gladsome tidings; with the Angels and the shepherds now glorify Him Who is willing to be gazed on as a young Child Who before the ages is God.

G: Trisagion (pg. 28): Holy God, Holy Might, Holy Immortal....

H: Liturgy of the Word: (pg. 31)

• *Epistle:* Hebrews 11:9-10; 32-40

• *Gospel:* Matthew 1:1-25

*I:* Usual Megalynarion of the Divine Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom – Tone 8: It is truly meet and right to bless thee, O Theotokos, who art ever blessed and all blameless and the Mother of our God. More Honorable than the Cherubim and more glorious beyond compare than the Seraphim: Thou who without stain barest God the Word, and art truly Theotokos, we magnify thee.
