Tone of the Week: 1 • Great Doxology: Tone 1

DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. JOHN CHRYSOSTOM

(Letters and page numbers below refer to the sections in “The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity” found in the pews)

A: First Antiphon (pg. 18): Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

B: Second Antiphon (pg. 20): Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

C: Third Antiphon and Little Entrance (pg. 24): During the Little Entrance, chant the Resurrectional Apolytikion. The Eisodikon (Entrance Hymn) is “O come, let us worship... save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead...”

D: Entrance Hymn: Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

- After the Little Entrance, sing these hymns in the following order:

E. Troparia:

- **Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 1:** While the stone was sealed by the Jews, and the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure body, Thou didst arise on the third day, O Savior, granting life to the world. For which cause the heavenly powers cried aloud unto Thee, O giver of life. Glory to Thy Resurrection, O Christ, glory to Thy kingdom, glory to Thy providence, O Thou Who alone art the lover of mankind.
- **Troparion of St. Ambrose of Milan – Tone 1:** Let us all honor the glorious Hierarch Ambrose, the namesake of ambrosia, the instructor of Italy, the protector of Christ's Church, and leader of Milan, a son of his diocese, and the greatest supporter of the poor, for he intercedes with the Lord to have mercy on our souls.
- **Troparion of All Saints of North America**

F: Kontakion of the Nativity of Christ – Tone 1: On this day the Virgin cometh to the cave to give birth to God the Word ineffably, Who was before all the ages. Dance for joy, O earth, on hearing the gladsome tidings; with the Angels and the shepherds now glorify Him Who is willing to be gazed on as a young Child Who before the ages is God.

G: Trisagion (pg. 28): Holy God, Holy Might, Holy Immortal....

H: Liturgy of the Word: (pg. 31)

- *Epistle:* Ephesians 5:8-19
- *Gospel:* Luke 13:10-17

I: Usual Megalynarion of the Divine Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom – Tone 8: It is truly meet and right to bless thee, O Theotokos, who art ever blessed and all blameless and the Mother of our God. More Honorable than the Cherubim and more glorious beyond compare than the Seraphim: Thou who without stain barest God the Word, and art truly Theotokos, we magnify thee.
