DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. BASIL THE GREAT

(Letters and page numbers below refer to the sections in “The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity” found in the pews)

A: First Antiphon (pg. 18): The light of Thy countenance, O Lord, has been signed upon us. Thou hast given to those that fear thee a sign, to flee from the bow.

Refrain: Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

Thou hast ascended on high, Thou hast led captivity captive. Thou hast given an inheritance to those that fear Thy Name, O Lord. (**Refrain**)

Glory... Both now... (Refrain)

B: Second Antiphon (pg. 20): All the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God. Let us worship at the place where His feet have stood.

Refrain: Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

God is our King before the ages; He has wrought salvation in the midst of the earth. (**Refrain**)

I will be exalted among the nations; I will be exalted in the earth. (**Refrain**)

Glory... Both now... O, only begotten Son and Word of God...

C: Third Antiphon and Little Entrance (pg. 24): Exalt ye the Lord our God, and worship at His footstool. O Lord, save Thy people and bless Thine inheritance. Feed them, and lift them up forever.

- *During the Little Entrance, after the verses of the Third Antiphon, chant the Apolytikion of the Holy Cross. The Eisodikon (Entrance Hymn) is “O come, let us worship... save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead...” as on ordinary Sundays. After the Little Entrance, chant these hymns in the following order:*

D: Entrance Hymn: Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

- *After the Little Entrance, sing these hymns in the following order:*

E. Troparia:

- **Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 7:** Thou didst shatter death by Thy Cross, Thou didst open paradise to the thief; Thou didst turn the sadness of the ointment-bearing women into joy. And didst bid Thine Apostles proclaim a warning, that Thou hast risen O Christ, granting to the world the Great Mercy.
- **Troparion of the Cross – Tone 1:** O Lord, save Thy people and bless Thine inheritance, and to thy faithful people grant victory over all their enemies, and by the power of Thy Cross protect all those who follow thee.

- ***Troparion of All Saints of North America***

F: Kontakion of Great Lent – Tone 8: To thee, the Champion Leader, do I offer thanks of victory, O Theotokos, thou who hast delivered me from terror; but as thou that hast that power invincible, O Theotokos, thou alone can set me free: from all forms of danger free me and deliver me, that I may cry unto thee: Hail, O Bride without Bridegroom.

G: Anti-Trisagion (pg. 28): Before Thy Cross we bow down in worship, Master, and Thy Holy Resurrection we glorify. (pg. 107 in the *Divine Liturgy book*)

H: Liturgy of the Word: (pg. 31)

- *Epistle:* Hebrews 4:14 – 5:6
- *Gospel:* Mark 8:34 – 9:1
