**Tone of the Week: 8 • Great Doxology: Tone 1**

#### DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. BASIL THE GREAT

*(Letters and page numbers below refer to the sections in “The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity” found in the pews)*

**A: First Antiphon (pg. 18):** Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

**B: Second Antiphon (pg. 20):** Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

**C: Third Antiphon and Little Entrance (pg. 24):**

- *During the Little Entrance, chant the Resurrectional Apolytikion. The Eisodikon (Entrance Hymn) is “O come, let us worship... save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead...”:*

**D: Entrance Hymn:** Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

- *After the Little Entrance, sing these hymns in the following order:*

#### **E. Troparia:**

- **Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 8:** From the heights Thou didst descend, O compassionate One, and Thou didst submit to the three-day burial, that Thou might deliver us from passion; Thou art our life and our Resurrection, O Lord, glory to Thee
- **Troparion of St. John Climacus – Tone 8:** The barren wilderness thou didst make fertile with the streams of thy tears; and by thy deep sighing thou hast given fruit through thy struggles a hundredfold. Accordingly, thou hast become a star for the universe, sparkling with miracles. Therefore, O righteous Father John Climacus, intercede with Christ God to save our souls.

**F: Kontakion of Great Lent – Tone 8:** To thee, the Champion Leader, do I offer thanks of victory, O Theotokos, thou who hast delivered me from terror; but as thou that hast that power invincible, O Theotokos, thou alone can set me free: from all forms of danger free me and deliver me, that I may cry unto thee: Hail, O Bride without Bridegroom.

**G: Trisagion (pg. 28):** Holy God, Holy Mighty, Holy Immortal, have mercy on us.

- *Epistle:* Hebrews 6:13-20
- *Gospel:* Mark 9:17-31
