Tone of the Week: 1 • Great Doxology: Tone 1

DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. BASIL THE GREAT

(Letters and page numbers below refer to the sections in “The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity” found in the pews)

A: First Antiphon (pg. 18): Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

B: Second Antiphon (pg. 20): Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

C: Third Antiphon and Little Entrance (pg. 24):

- *During the Little Entrance, chant the Resurrectional Apolytikion. The Eisodikon (Entrance Hymn) is “O come, let us worship... save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead...”:*

D: Entrance Hymn: Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

- *After the Little Entrance, sing these hymns in the following order:*

E. Troparia:

- **Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 1:** While the stone was sealed by the Jews, and the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure body, Thou didst arise on the third day, O Savior, granting life to the world. For which cause the heavenly powers cried aloud unto Thee, O giver of life. Glory to Thy Resurrection, O Christ, glory to Thy kingdom, glory to Thy providence, O Thou Who alone art the lover of mankind.
- **Troparion of St. Mary of Egypt – Tone 8:** Through thee, the divine likeness was securely preserved, O mother Mary; for thou didst carry the cross and follow Christ. By example and precept thou didst teach us to ignore the body, because it is perishable, and to attend to the concerns of the undying soul. Therefore, doth thy soul rejoice with the angels.
- **Troparion of All Saints of North America**

F: Kontakion for Typical Sunday – Tone 2 (pg. 27 in The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity): O undisputed intercessor of Christians, the Mediatrix who is unrejected by the Creator: Turn not away from the voice of our petitions, although we be sinners. Come to us, in time, with aid as we cry unto thee in faith, for thou art good. Hasten to us with intercessions, O Theotokos, who dist ever intercede for those who honor thee.

G: Trisagion (pg. 28): Holy God, Holy Mighty, Holy Immortal, have mercy on us.

H: Liturgy of the Word: (pg. 31)

- *Epistle:* Hebrews 9:11-14
- *Gospel:* Mark 10:32-45
