**PENTECOST SUNDAY**

**Tone of the Week: 6 • Great Doxology: Tone 1**

**DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. JOHN CHRYSOSTOM**

*(Letters and page numbers below refer to the sections in “The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity” found in the pews)*

**A: First Antiphon (pg. 18):** The heavens declare the glory of God, and the firmament proclaimeth the work of His hands. Day unto day poureth forth speech, and night unto night proclaimeth knowledge.

**Refrain:** Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

There are neither tongues nor words in which their voices are not heard. Their sound hath gone forth into all the earth, and their words unto the ends of the world. **(Refrain)**

Glory... Both now... **(Refrain)**

**B: Second Antiphon (pg. 20):** The Lord hear thee in the day of affliction; the Name of the God of Jacob defend thee. Let Him send forth unto thee help from His sanctuary, and out of Zion let Him help thee.

**Refrain:** Save us, O Good Comforter, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

Let Him remember every sacrifice of thine, and thy whole-burnt offering let Him fatten. **(Refrain)**

The Lord grant thee according to thy heart, and fulfill all thy purposes. **(Refrain)**

Glory... Both now... O, only begotten Son and Word of God...

**C: Third Antiphon and Little Entrance (pg. 24):** O Lord, in Thy strength the king shall be glad, and in Thy salvation shall he rejoice exceedingly. The desire of his heart hast Thou granted unto him, and hast not denied him the request of his lips. Thou wentest before him with blessings of goodness, Thou hast set upon his head a crown of precious stones. He asked life of Thee, and Thou gavest him length of days unto ages of ages.

- *During the Little Entrance, after the Third Antiphon verses, chant the Apolytikion of Pentecost.*

**D: Entrance Hymn:**

- **Priest:** Be Thou exalted, O Lord, in Thy strength; we shall praise and sing of Thy mighty acts.
- **Choir:** Save us, O Good Comforter, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

- *After the Little Entrance, sing these hymns in the following order:*

**E. Troparia:**

- **Troparion of the Pentecost – Tone 8:** Blessed art Thou, O Christ our God, Who hast revealed the fishermen as most wise, having sent upon them the Holy Spirit, and through them Thou hast fished the universe, O Lover of mankind, glory to Thee.
- **Troparion of All Saints of North America - Not sung today.**

**F: Kontakion of Pentecost– Tone 8:** When the High One descended, confusing tongues, He divided the nations. And when He distributed the fiery tongues He called all to one unity. Wherefore, in unison we glorify the most Holy Spirit.

**G: Anti-Trisagion (pg. 28):** As many of you as were baptized into Christ....

**H: Liturgy of the Word: (pg. 31)**

- *Epistle:* Acts 2:1-11
- *Gospel:* John 7:37-52; 8:12

**I: Megalyarion of Pentecost – Tone 7:** O thou who without experience of corruption wast found to be with child, and didst lend flesh unto the Word Who devised all things, O thou Mother who hast not known wedlock, O Virgin Theotokos, vessel of the Uncontainable One, dwelling place of thy boundless Fashioner, thee do we magnify.

- *Instead of singing “We have seen the true light,” sing the Apolytikion of Pentecost.*
