DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. JOHN CHRYSOSTOM

(Letters and page numbers below refer to the sections in “The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity” found in the pews)

A: First Antiphon (pg. 18): Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

B: Second Antiphon (pg. 20): Save us, O Son of God, who art risen from the dead, who sing to thee, Alleluia.

C: Third Antiphon and Little Entrance (pg. 24):

- During the Little Entrance, chant the Resurrectional Apolytikion. After the Little Entrance, chant these hymns in the following order:

D: Entrance Hymn: Save us, O Son of God, who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

- After the Little Entrance, sing these hymns in the following order:

E. Troparia:

- **Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 7** (pg. 101 in *The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity*): Thou didst shatter death by Thy Cross, Thou didst open paradise to the thief; Thou didst turn the sadness of the ointment-bearing women into joy. And didst bid Thine Apostles proclaim a warning, that Thou hast risen O Christ, granting to the world the Great Mercy.
- **Troparion of St. Paraskeva (Tone 1):** Showing a diligence befitting thy calling, O namesake of preparedness, thou hast gained, as thy dwelling, a faith worthy of thy name, O prize-winning Paraskeva. Hence, thou pourest forth healings and intercedes for our souls.
- **Troparion of St. Jacob Netsvetov (Tone 4):** O righteous Father Jacob, adornment of Atka and the Yukon Delta; thou didst offer thyself as a living sacrifice to bring light to a searching people. Offspring of Russian America, flower of brotherly unity, healer of sickness and terror of demons: O Holy Father Jacob, pray to Christ God that our souls may be saved!
- **Troparion of All Saints of North America – Tone 1:** The first fruits of sanctity....

F: Kontakion for Typical Sunday – Tone 2 (pg. 27 in *The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity*): O undisputed intercessor of Christians, the Mediatrix who is unrejected by the Creator: Turn not away from the voice of our petitions, although we be sinners. Come to us, in time, with aid as we cry unto thee in faith, for thou art good. Hasten to us with intercessions, O Theotokos, who dist ever intercede for those who honor thee.

G: Trisagion (pg. 28): Holy God, Holy Mighty, Holy Immortal....
