Tone of the Week: 4 • Great Doxology: Tone 1

DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. JOHN CHRYSOSTOM

(Letters and page numbers below refer to the sections in “The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity” found in the pews)

A: First Antiphon (pg. 18): Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

B: Second Antiphon (pg. 20): Save us, O Son of God, who art risen from the dead, who sing to thee, Alleluia.

C: Third Antiphon and Little Entrance (pg. 24):

- *During the Little Entrance, chant the Resurrectional Apolytikion. After the Little Entrance, chant these hymns in the following order:*

D: Entrance Hymn: Save us, O Son of God, who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

- *After the Little Entrance, sing these hymns in the following order:*

E. Troparia:

- **Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 4** (pg. 96 in *The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity*): Having learned the joyful message of the Resurrection from the angel the women disciples of the Lord cast from them their parental condemnation. And proudly broke the news to the Disciples, saying: Death hath been spoiled; Christ God is risen, granting the world Great Mercy.
- **Troparion of St. Athanasius the Athonite – Tone 3:** The Angels’ ranks were awed by thy life in the flesh, how, though corporeal, and clad with earthly clay, thou didst set forth with courage to invisible wars and wrestlings and didst boldly smite the hordes of the demons with mortal wounds. Wherefore, Christ rewarded thee with abundant gifts in return. Entreat Him that our souls find salvation, O most renowned Father Athanasius.
- **Troparion of All Saints of North America – Tone 1:** The first fruits of sanctity....

F: Kontakion for Typical Sunday – Tone 2 (pg. 27 in *The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity*): O undisputed intercessor of Christians, the Mediatrix who is unrejected by the Creator: Turn not away from the voice of our petitions, although we be sinners. Come to us, in time, with aid as we cry unto thee in faith, for thou art good. Hasten to us with intercessions, O Theotokos, who dist ever intercede for those who honor thee.

G: Trisagion (pg. 28): *Holy God, Holy Mighty, Holy Immortal....*

- *Epistle:* Galatians 5:22-6:2
- *Gospel:* Matthew 8:28 – 9:1
