Tone of the Week: 2 • Great Doxology: Tone 1

DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. JOHN CHRYSOSTOM

(Letters and page numbers below refer to the sections in “The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity” found in the pews)

A: First Antiphon (pg. 18): Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

B: Second Antiphon (pg. 20): Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

C: Third Antiphon and Little Entrance (pg. 24)

- During the Little Entrance, chant the Resurrectional Apolytikion. The Eisodikon (Entrance Hymn) is “O come, let us worship... save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead...” After the Little Entrance, sing these hymns in the following order:

Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 2 (pg. 93 in *The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity*): When Thou didst submit Thyself unto death, O Thou deathless and immortal One, then Thou didst destroy hades with Thy Godly power. And when Thou didst raise the dead from beneath the earth, all the powers of Heaven did cry aloud unto Thee: O Christ, Thou giver of life, glory to Thee.

- Sing the apolytikion of the patron saint or feast of the temple.

Kontakion of the Nativity of the Theotokos – Tone 4: By thy holy nativity, O pure one, Joachim and Anna were delivered from the reproach of barrenness; and Adam and Eve were delivered from the corruption of death; thy people do celebrate it, having been saved from the stain of iniquity, crying unto thee: The barren doth give birth to the Theotokos, who nourisheth our life.

G: Trisagion (pg. 28): Usual Sunday

H: Liturgy of the Word: (pg. 31)

- Gospel: Matthew 18:23-35
