Tone of the Week: 7 • Great Doxology: Tone 1

DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. JOHN CHRYSOSTOM

(Letters and page numbers below refer to the sections in “The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity” found in the pews)

A: First Antiphon (pg. 18): Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

B: Second Antiphon (pg. 20): Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

C: Third Antiphon and Little Entrance (pg. 24): The Lord reigneth, let the people rage; He sitteth upon the cherubim, let the earth be shaken. The Lord is great in Zion; and He is high above all peoples. Let them confess Thy great Name, for it is terrible and holy.

- *During the Little Entrance, chant the Resurrectional Apolytikion. The Eisodikon (Entrance Hymn) is “O come, let us worship... save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead...” After the Little Entrance, sing these hymns in the following order:*

D: Entrance Hymn: Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

E. Troparia:

- **Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 7:** Thou didst shatter death by Thy Cross, Thou didst open paradise to the thief; Thou didst turn the sadness of the ointment-bearing women into joy. And didst bid Thine Apostles proclaim a warning, that Thou hast risen O Christ, granting to the world the Great Mercy.
- **Troparion of St. Chariton the Confessor – Tone 8:** The barren wilderness thou didst make fertile with the streams of thy tears; and by thy deep sighing thou hast given fruit through thy struggles a hundred-fold. Accordingly, thou hast become a star for the universe, sparkling with miracles. Therefore, O righteous Father Chariton, intercede with Christ God to save our souls.
- *Sing the apolytikion of the patron saint or feast of the temple.*

F: Kontakion for Typical Sunday – Tone 2 (pg. 27 in The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity): O undisputed intercessor of Christians, the Mediatrix who is unrejected by the Creator: Turn not away from the voice of our petitions, although we be sinners. Come to us, in time, with aid as we cry unto thee in faith, for thou art good. Hasten to us with intercessions, O Theotokos, who dist ever intercede for those who honor thee.

G: Trisagion (pg. 28): Holy God, Holy Might, Holy Immortal....

H: Liturgy of the Word: (pg. 31)

- *Epistle:* 2 Corinthians 6:1-10
- *Gospel:* Luke 5:1-11

I: Usual Megalynarion of the Divine Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom – Tone 8: It is truly meet and right to bless thee, O Theotokos, who art ever blessed and all blameless and the Mother of our God. More Honorable than the Cherubim and more glorious beyond compare than the Seraphim: Thou who without stain barest God the Word, and art truly Theotokos, we magnify thee.
