DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. BASIL THE GREAT

(Letters and page numbers below refer to the sections in "The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity" found in the pews)

A: First Antiphon (pg. 18): Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

B: Second Antiphon (pg. 20): Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead; who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

C: Third Antiphon (pg. 24): During the Little Entrance, chant the Resurrectional Apolytikion.

D: Entrance Hymn (pg. 25): Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead; who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

• After the Entrance, sing the hymns in the following order below.

**E:** Troparia (pg. 26):

*Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 5* (pg. 97 in *The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity*): Let us believers praise and worship the Word; coeternal with the Father and the Spirit, born of the Virgin for our salvation. For, He took pleasure in ascending the Cross in the flesh to suffer death; and to raise the dead by His glorious Resurrection.

**Troparion of St. Mary of Egypt – Tone 8:** Through thee, the divine likeness was securely preserved, O mother Mary; for thou didst carry the cross and follow Christ. By example and precept thou didst teach us to ignore the body, because it is perishable, and to attend to the concerns of the undying soul. Therefore, doth thy soul rejoice with the angels.

*Troparion of All Saints of North America – Tone 1* (pg. 26 in *The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity*)

F: Kontakion for Ordinary Sundays – Tone 2 (pg. 27 in The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity):

O undisputed intercessor of Christians, the Mediatrix who is unrejected by the Creator; turn not away from the voice of our petitions, although we be sinners. Come to us, in time, with aid as we cry unto thee in faith, for thou art good. Hasten to us with intercessions, O Theotokos, who didst ever intercede for those that honor thee.
