SUMMER PROGRAM INFORMATION

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP \$40: Every child must be a member of the Boys & Girls Club of North Lake Tahoe. BGCNLT Memberships are \$40 for all youth K – 12th grade. Summer programming is not available for incoming TK students.

WEEKLY SUMMER DAY CAMP FEE: The weekly day camp fee for Kinder - 6th graders is \$120. Fields trip are NOT included and may vary in cost. Specialty Camp fees vary, please refer to Specialty Camp pages for more details. Youth participating in specialty camps may add-on the full day for an additional \$65 per week. There is no weekly fee for Teen drop-in hours. Additional fees apply to field trips, specialty camps etc.

REFUND POLICY: Refunds will be issued only if a camp is cancelled.



SCHOLARSHIPS: We offer discounted fees to qualifying families. Please pick up a scholarship packet at the front desk if interested.

Field Trips: Field Trips will be announced Monday, April 15th. Field trips will require a separate registration through Active. Schedules, pricing, and availability will vary by site and week. Members attending field trips will be required to purchase and wear a field trip t-shirt in order to attend. Club members signed-up for Specialty Camps that conflict with a field trip will not be permitted to register.

MEALS: All campers are offered breakfast, lunch, and a snack.

BGCNLT meals are made possible through the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP). BGCNLT is an equal opportunity provider. Additional Information:

- Enrollment in Specialty Camps does NOT include Day Camps or field trips. Members must be picked up immediately following the end of the Specialty Camp. Full-day extensions (Including Friday) can be added onto Specialty camps for \$65 per week.
- Campers must wear sneakers, appropriate clothing for each day's activities, bring a water bottle, and apply sunscreen at home before camp.
- Bikes, scooters, and skateboards are allowed but must be locked up and brought home each day. Helmets are required. BGCNLT is not responsible for stolen or damaged personal items.
- The Club closes at 5:00PM each night. A fee will be charged to families who are late to pick up their campers.
- Drop-off time for Day Camp will be 8:00AM 9:00AM. Pick-up time will be 3:00PM 5:00PM.




