SUMMER FIELD TRIP GUIDELINES

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP \$40: Every child must have a current membership to attend field trips.

- **ELOP Families receive discounted rates; refer to email instructions.**
- **Register via Active.com; schedules, pricing, and availability vary per site and are subject to change.**
- **Field trip participants must be registered for day camp or pay an additional \$50 daily rate.**
- **Youth must purchase and wear a \$10 field trip t-shirt on all field trips; available at the front desk.**
- **Specialty Camp cannot register for overlapping field trips.**
- **BGCNLT provides all transportation; parents cannot drop off/pick up at field trip locations.**
- **Participants may bring extra spending money at their own risk; BGCNLT Staff will not hold or carry personal belongings or money.**

REFUND POLICY: Refunds will be issued only if a field trip is cancelled.

SCHOLARSHIPS: We offer discounted fees to qualifying families. Please pick up a scholarship packet at the front desk if interested.

MEALS: All campers are offered breakfast, lunch, and a snack.
