We finished up summer camp at three sites, and wow, we had a GREAT time. Campers participated in all day fun in Kings Beach, Truckee, and at the Duffield Youth Program in Incline Village. In total, across all three sites, BGCNLT had 985 participants registered in summer camps with an average of 373 attending daily. Specialty camps were offered at all sites and focused on aviation, sports, art, mountain biking, Lego Robotics, dance, and more.

Our Teen Center was bursting at the seams in Kings Beach with 69 participants who had fun at local beaches, at Teen Takeovers in the Club, and on exciting field trips in and out of the basin. A group of 10 teens finished off the summer with a 3 day, 2 night backpacking trip. For many participants, it was their first time on the trail and they are now officially hooked!

Two summer shows produced by Great Futures Productions wowed audiences—after only two weeks of rehearsing. Younger campers participated in Cinderella Jr. and our teen members put on Bye Bye Birdie.


