SUMMER PROGRAM INFORMATION

SUMMER MEMBERSHIP \$20: Every child must have an active summer membership for the Boys & Girls Club of North Lake Tahoe.

BGCNLT Memberships are \$20 for all youth K - 12th grades. Summer programming is not available for incoming TK students.

Teens (6th - 12th) must register for both a teen summer membership \$20 and the teen summer program \$150 in order to attend.

Registrations completed for Summer 2026 will include access to the after-school program for the 2026-2027 school year.

WEEKLY SUMMER DAY CAMP FEE: The weekly day camp fee for KB Kinder - 5th & TES & Incline Kinder - 6th grade fee is **\$165**. Field trips are NOT included and may vary in cost. Specialty Camp fees vary, please refer to Specialty Camp pages for more details. Youth participating in specialty camps may add on the **full day for the week an additional \$80**. There is no weekly fee for Teen drop-in hours. **Summer daily drop-in rate \$82.50/day**. Additional fees apply to field trips, specialty camps, etc.

REFUND POLICY: Refunds will be issued only if a camp or field trip is cancelled by BGCNLT.

SCHOLARSHIPS: We offer discounted fees to qualifying families. Financial assistance application must be submitted via the MyClubHub Parent Portal. Staff will review within 72 hours of submission.

Field Trips: Field Trip registration will open on **Monday, April 20th** at noon. Field trips will require a separate registration through Myclubhub. Schedules, pricing, and availability will vary by site and week. Members attending field trips will be required to purchase and wear a field trip t-shirt in order to attend. Club members signed-up for Specialty Camps that conflict with a field trip will not be permitted to register.

MEALS: All campers are offered breakfast, lunch, and a snack.

BGCNLT meals are made possible through the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP). BGCNLT is an equal opportunity provider. Additional Information:

- Enrollment in Specialty Camps does NOT include Day Camps or field trips. Members must be picked up immediately following the end of the Specialty Camp. Full-day extensions (Including Friday) can be added onto Specialty camps for \$80 per week. Summer daily drop-in rate \$82.50/day.
- Campers must wear sneakers, appropriate clothing for each day's activities, bring a water bottle, and apply sunscreen at home before camp.
- Bikes, scooters, and skateboards are allowed but must be locked up and brought home each day. Helmets are required. BGCNLT is not responsible for stolen or damaged personal items.
- Morning Drop-off time for Summer Day Camp will be 8:00AM - 9:00AM.
- The Club closes at 5:30PM each night. A fee of \$1.00 per minute will be charged to families who are late to pick up their campers.
