

2021 Year in Review

Distance Learning & Enrichment Programs

- From distance learning support in Kings Beach and Truckee, to after-school enrichment programs at the Duffield Youth Program in Incline Village, all Sites adapted programming on numerous occasions to best meet the needs of kids and families.
- Outside of Club, 40 Club Members participated in Powder Hounds at Northstar. The program provided free lift tickets, ski school, rental equipment, and other services to enhance access to winter sports and inspire the next generation of skiiers and riders.



<u>Summer</u>

 Over the summer, we served an average of 234 members/day across 3 Sites (for the first time ever in Truckee!) while also launching several Mountain Sports & Recreation programs including mountain biking, stand-up paddle boarding, teen hiking, basketball, soccer, and tennis!

Wine on the Water

- 3 Wine on the Water Wine Dinners were sold out with 77 people attending in total. The magnificent 5-course dinners were prepared by Chef Shane Hammett of Sage Leaf Restaurant in Incline Village and Frank Family Vineyards wine was presented by Kristi Snyder, former Sommelier at the Lone Eagle Grille at the Hyatt Regency in Incline Village.
- 8 Magnums of the Frank Family Reserve Cabernet were auctioned off at the dinners



- and 25 online auction items were sold raising an additional \$7,000 and \$18,095 respectively for the Club!
- 6 outstanding hosts and 6 companies sponsored the event, in total yielding over \$100,000 in net proceeds for BGCNLT!

- Back at Club, we organized a fun and spooky Halloweenthemed Harvest Fest with walk-through stations, distributed over 500 Turkey Dinners at our Thanksgiving Dinner (thanks to the generous support of The Ritz Carlton, Lake Tahoe), and spread the holiday spirit with a festive "Tree Lighting Ceremony" at the North Tahoe Event Center.
