# SUMMER PROGRAM INFORMATION

**SUMMER MEMBERSHIP \$20:** Every camper must be a member of the Boys & Girls Club of North Lake Tahoe. BGCNLT Summer Memberships are \$20 for all youth K - 12th grade. (Summer membership and programming is not available for incoming TK students. School Year registration will begin the first week of August.)

**WEEKLY SUMMER DAY CAMP FEE:** The weekly day camp fee for Kinder - 6th graders is \$100. Fields trip are included. Specialty Camp fees vary, please refer to Specialty Camp pages for more details. Youth participating in specialty camps may add-on the full day for an additional \$50 per week. There is no weekly fee for Teen drop-in hours. Additional fees may apply to field trips, specialty camps etc.

**REFUND POLICY:** Refunds will be issued only if a camp is canceled.

**SCHOLARSHIPS:** We offer discounted fees to qualifying families. Please pick up a scholarship packet at the front desk if interested.

**MEALS:** All campers are offered breakfast, lunch, and a snack.

## Important Facts:

- Enrollment in Specialty Camps does NOT include Day Camps. Members must be picked up immediately following the end of the Specialty Camp. Add-on full day camp for additional \$50/week.
- Campers must wear sneakers and appropriate clothing for each day's activities.
- Bikes, scooters, and skateboards are allowed but must be locked up and brought home each day. Helmets are required. BGCNLT is not responsible for stolen or damaged personal items.
- The Club closes at 5:00PM each night. A fee will be charged to families who are late to pick up their campers.
