WHATEVER CONTROLS YOUR HEART: A recent Twitter feed by one of my favorite authors, Paul David Tripp, said, "Whatever controls your heart will set the morals by which you live." This message rings true for each one of us, and also for the youth in our public schools. At Bible in the Schools, we recognize that the destructive influences on our youth often have the strongest hold on them, controlling many of their choices and actions. Thus, for 94 years, Bible in the Schools has been providing the next generation with the life-affirming and positive influence of the Bible.

FOLLOWING THE LOUDEST VOICE: Many students in our public schools are also living with huge deficits.
