THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD



JOURNEY TOWARD GOD

In our celebration of the Epiphany, two interwoven themes are present in the readings today. God is beginning something new, and God gathers all of humanity to participate. For Isaiah, God's bright light, manifested in the people of Israel, attracts and summons people from many nations to Jerusalem. In the letter to the Ephesians, God's grace makes the Gentiles co-heirs and co-partners in the gospel. Matthew tells the story of the fulfillment of God's promises to Israel through the birth of Jesus, and simultaneously leading foreigners to share in these same promises. With the birth of Jesus, God chose a particular people, in a particular time and place, to enter most directly into the human story. Today's readings teach that God did this in order to gather all people, all cultures, into unity with God. Like the magi, we are drawn into a journey toward God, becoming co-partners in God's work.

Second Reading: Ephesians 3:2-3a, 5-6


Gospel: Matthew 2:1-12

THE ADORATION OF THE MAGI

Regarding this event commemorated on the feast of the Epiphany, it is helpful to again turn to the Catechism, which states: “In the magi, representatives of the neighboring pagan religions, the Gospel sees the first fruits of the nations, who welcome the good news of salvation through the Incarnation. The magi’s coming to Jerusalem to pay homage to the king of the Jews shows that they seek in Israel, in the messianic light of the star of David, the one who will be king of the nations.” This adoration of the magi is of immense importance, as it shows the possibility of redemption for everyone who seeks it.

The symbolism involved in the adoration of the magi has several layers, but the first one is relatively easy to see. The worship of Jesus by the Magi shows us that Jesus’ kingship began at his birth and superseded all other earthly kinds of royalty. Though the magi are often referred to as the three kings, it is not clear that they were in fact that specific type of royalty. According to Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI, the term “Magi” encompasses several different meanings. In terms of their religion, it is thought that the magi were members of a Persian priestly caste. They are also thought to have been philosophers, and others say they were involved in some way with the supernatural or astrology. Regardless of the variety of definitions one could apply to the term Magi, it is clear that these were men who held a certain amount of power and influence in the world at that time. The fact that they embarked on a journey and ultimately bowed down at the manger of Jesus shows that the kingship of Jesus supersedes all earthly power.

The adoration of the Magi also shows us how it is possible for the Old Testament to be fulfilled in the New. If the Magi were indeed members of a priestly caste, it is of great significance that those priests would surrender to the priesthood of Jesus as shown in the New Testament. In this way, we can see the words of Jesus born out in this event that occurred after the Nativity, after this occurrence of the Incarnation: “Behold, I make all things new.” *Cora Evans*

LA ADORACIÓN DE LOS MAGOS

Con respecto a este evento que se conmemora en la fiesta de la Epifanía, es útil volver al Catecismo, que dice: “En los magos, representantes de las religiones paganas vecinas, el Evangelio ve los primeros frutos de las naciones, que acogen la buena noticia de salvación a través de la Encarnación. La llegada de los magos a Jerusalén para rendir homenaje al rey de los judíos muestra que buscan en Israel, a la luz mesiánica de la estrella de David, al que será el rey de las naciones”. Esta adoración de los magos es de inmensa importancia, ya que muestra la posibilidad de redención para todo aquel que la busque.

El simbolismo involucrado en la adoración de los magos tiene varias capas, pero la primera es relativamente fácil de ver. La adoración de Jesús por los magos nos muestra que el reinado de Jesús comenzó en su nacimiento y reemplazó a todos los demás tipos de realeza terrenal. Aunque a menudo se hace referencia a los magos como los tres reyes, no está claro que fueran de hecho ese tipo específico de realeza. Según el Papa Emérito Benedicto XVI, el término “Magos” abarca varios significados diferentes. En cuanto a su religión, se cree que los magos eran miembros de una casta sacerdotal persa. También se cree que fueron filósofos, y otros dicen que estuvieron involucrados de alguna manera con lo sobrenatural o la astrología. Independientemente de la variedad de definiciones que uno podría aplicar al término Magos, está claro que se trataba de hombres que tenían una cierta cantidad de poder e influencia en el mundo en ese momento. El hecho de que se embarcaron en un viaje y finalmente se postraron ante el pesebre de Jesús muestra que el reinado de Jesús reemplaza todo poder terrenal.

La adoración de los magos también nos muestra cómo es posible que el Antiguo Testamento se cumpla en el Nuevo. Si los magos fueran realmente miembros de una casta sacerdotal, es de gran importancia que esos sacerdotes se rindieran al sacerdocio de Jesús como se muestra en el Nuevo Testamento. De esta manera, podemos ver nacer las palabras de Jesús en este evento que ocurrió después de la Natividad, después de este acontecimiento de la Encarnación: “He aquí, hago nuevas todas las cosas”.





Feast of the Epiphany January 2, 2021

Epiphany Home Blessing *Bendición del hogar en la Epifanía*



In many Eastern European countries, it is customary to bless the home on the feast of the Epiphany. While this blessing is often done by a priest, families may also bless their home. The blessing includes writing “20+C+M+B+20” on the lintel of the home’s doorway with chalk. The numbers stand for the year in which the blessing is inscribed (2020.) The letters “CMB” stand for traditional names of the Magi (Caspar, Melchior, Balthasar.) They are also an abbreviation for the latin blessing: *Christus mansionem benedicat*, which means “Christ bless this dwelling.”

BLESSING THE HOUSE

The family gathers at the front door.

Leader: Let us pray. Lord, Our God bless this home that it may be sacred and full of life. Bless this home that it may be place of honor, work, and prayer. Keep all who live and enter here forever in your care. Protect us from all harm. In thanksgiving to God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

All: Amen

*Then the leader or someone else writes
“20+C+M+B+20” on the door’s lintel.*

Leader: We bless this home in thanksgiving to God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

All: Amen


