FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



THEOPHANIES

Today's readings recount three theophanies, or particular manifestations of God's presence. The prophet Isaiah is caught up in a dramatic scene of heavenly worship, with a royal throne, burning embers, and seraphim singing, "Holy, holy, holy." Isaiah is overwhelmed. In the responsorial psalm, the assembly adds its own worship to that of the seraphim: "In the sight of the angels, I will sing your praises, Lord" (Psalm 138:1).

Paul reminds the Corinthians of his own experience of a post-Resurrection appearance of the Lord, making him an apostle, but one "born abnormally" (1 Corinthians 15:8), since he had no acquaintance with the earthly Jesus. The first of those who did know the earthly Jesus were surprised by fishing advice from the teacher who had commandeered Simon's boat, resulting in an extraordinary catch. Although less colorful than those of Isaiah or Paul, this theophany was just as overwhelming.

STEWARDSHIP, LEADERSHIP AND RELATIONSHIP: HOW THEY WORK TOGETHER

Relationships are the stuff of leadership. A congregation is a web of relationships. To practice the people skills needed for leadership, ask yourself: What kind of a human being do I need to become so that I can practice leadership? As Catholics, we are committed to inner change. Jesus calls us to form our hearts out of his love (Luke 10:27). Ashes during Lent are but one example of how we acknowledge that we are committed to change our hearts, our minds and ourselves to become better human beings. Research shows that we can become compassionate communicators by nurturing an inner silence, being fully present to the moment and listening deeply to others. For Catholics, this entails a rich spiritual life of prayer and reflection on Scripture. Prayer has a powerful effect on the one who prays. It transforms our hearts, our minds, and our actions. Leadership is an inside-out activity. It begins with work on the inside and moves toward engaging people on the outside. The formation of the heart is our path to leadership and to holiness. The heart is the place where we can find the quiet of the soul, connect with God and develop the capacity to know, love and serve God and each other – heart to heart – before we can lead each other. Neuroscientists teach that the key to happy, healthy, spiritually fulfilling lives is forming the connections between the heart and the brain. When we actively participate in the Mass, pray the rosary with full consciousness or spend prayerful time in Eucharistic adoration, we strengthen the connections between our head and heart. Scripture teaches us to form our hearts in love, and then to listen to our carefully formed hearts, to be attentive to matters of the heart and intentional about following the message that the Spirit moves into our heart. Forming the heart prepares us for leadership. Are you ready to say, “Here I am Lord, Send Me”?

La investigación muestra que podemos convertirnos en comunicadores compasivos al fomentar un silencio interior, estar completamente presentes en el momento y escuchar profundamente a los demás. Para los católicos, esto implica una rica vida espiritual de oración y reflexión sobre las Escrituras. La oración tiene un efecto poderoso en el que ora. Transforma nuestros corazones, nuestras mentes y nuestras acciones. El liderazgo es una actividad de adentro hacia afuera. Comienza con el trabajo en el interior y avanza hacia la participación de las personas en el exterior. La formación del corazón es nuestro camino hacia el liderazgo y hacia la santidad. El corazón es el lugar donde podemos encontrar la tranquilidad del alma, conectarnos con Dios y desarrollar la capacidad de conocer, amar y servir a Dios y a los demás, de corazón a corazón, antes de que podamos guiarnos unos a otros. Los neurocientíficos enseñan que la clave para una vida feliz, saludable y espiritualmente plena es formar las conexiones entre el corazón y el cerebro. Cuando participamos activamente en la Misa, rezamos el rosario con plena conciencia o dedicamos tiempo de oración a la adoración eucarística, fortalecemos las conexiones entre nuestra cabeza y nuestro corazón. Las Escrituras nos enseñan a formar nuestros corazones en el amor, y luego a escuchar nuestros corazones cuidadosamente formados, a estar atentos a los asuntos del corazón y a seguir intencionalmente el mensaje que el Espíritu mueve en nuestro corazón. Formar el corazón nos prepara para el liderazgo. ¿Estás listo para decir: “Aquí estoy, Señor, envíame”?
