THE SPIRITUALITY OF STEWARDSHIP: A PROCESS OF CONVERSION

Stewardship requires an ongoing process of conversion. This is true in our own lives, and in the life of our parish or diocese and involves four inter-related steps (see *United States bishops’ pastoral letter, Stewardship: A Disciple’s Response* (USCCB Publishing, Washington, D.C. (quotations are cited in the tenth anniversary edition, 2002)):

1. Commitment. Living as disciples requires us to make a “conscious, firm decision, carried out in action, to be followers of Jesus Christ no matter the cost to themselves.” (*Stewardship*, p. 5). As stewardship leaders, we grow in our own commitment to Christ and invite others to do so as well. Our commitment as Christians becomes the vision and purpose for our lives.

2. Call. Disciples answer the call of the Lord in their daily lives. Jesus does not only call once, but over and over, throughout the course of our lives. This truly is life-changing! When people grasp that they are called to carry out Christ’s mission in the world, their lives take on new and greater meaning.

3. Discernment. Discernment is more than simply deciding to do something. It is a process of prayerfully aligning our heart and life with God, recognizing our many blessings, and responding out of gratitude by sharing the gifts that have been entrusted to us. Discernment is sometimes a straight-forward process of doing what we know is right, but often needs and benefits from the companionship of others, as we listen for and respond to the promptings of the Holy Spirit.

4. Action. It is not enough to know ourselves as Christ’s people and to become attentive to the Lord’s call. “This commitment is expressed not in a single action, nor even in a number of actions over a period of time, but in an entire way of life...” (*Stewardship*, p. 5).

This conversion process is about having a vision of ourselves and our faith communities as disciples and stewards firmly in mind and moving more toward the vision every step of the way.

LA ESPIRITUALIDAD DE LA MAYORDOMÍA: UN PROCESO DE CONVERSIÓN

La corresponsabilidad requiere un proceso continuo de conversión. Esto es cierto en nuestras propias vidas y en la vida de nuestra parroquia o diócesis e involucra cuatro pasos interrelacionados (ver la carta pastoral de los obispos de los Estados Unidos, *Stewardship: A Disciple’s Response* (USCCB Publishing, Washington, DC) (las citas se citan en la edición del décimo aniversario, 2002)):

1. Compromiso. Vivir como discípulos requiere que tomemos una “decisión consciente, firme, llevada a cabo en acción, de ser seguidores de Jesucristo sin importar el costo para ellos mismos”. (*Mayordomía*, pág. 5). Como líderes de mayordomía, crecemos en nuestro propio compromiso con Cristo e invitamos a otros a que también lo hagan. Nuestro compromiso como cristianos se convierte en la visión y el propósito de nuestras vidas.

2. Llamado. Los discípulos responden al llamado del Señor en su vida diaria. Jesús no solo llama una vez, sino una y otra vez, a lo largo de nuestras vidas. ¡Esto realmente cambia la vida! Cuando las personas comprenden que están llamadas a llevar a cabo la misión de Cristo en el mundo, sus vidas adquieren un sentido nuevo y mayor.

3. Discernimiento. El discernimiento es más que simplemente decidir hacer algo. Es un proceso de alinear en oración nuestro corazón y nuestra vida con Dios, reconocer nuestras muchas bendiciones y responder con gratitud al compartir los dones que se nos han confiado. El discernimiento es a veces un proceso sencillo de hacer lo que sabemos que es correcto, pero a menudo necesita y se beneficia de la compañía de otros, mientras escuchamos y respondemos a las inspiraciones del Espíritu Santo.

4. Acción. No basta con saberse pueblo de Cristo y estar atento a la llamada del Señor. “Este compromiso no se expresa en una sola acción, ni siquiera en una serie de acciones durante un período de tiempo, sino en toda una forma de vida...” (*Stewardship*, p. 5).

Este proceso de conversión se trata de tener una visión de nosotros mismos y de nuestras comunidades de fe como discípulos y administradores firmes en mente y avanzar más hacia la visión en cada paso del camino.


ELIMINATE HUNGER
