LOVE AS GOD LOVES

Our Gospel today continues Jesus' Sermon on the Plain, in which we heard Luke's version of the Beatitudes. This week, Jesus gives us new "commandments," telling us how to live and act in the world as his disciples, rooted in the radical love of God for humanity. It reminds us of his later speech about loving one another as he loves us, in other words with a God-like love, the kind we see in today's psalm about God's mercy. How else could we do as Jesus tells us by loving our enemies, which seems impossible, until we remember that God gave us the example of Jesus, who is like God but also like us? David understands this merciful love when he spares the life of his enemy in the first reading. Finally, Paul tells us that we will become like Jesus if we act as he did, as God does.

LOVE YOUR ENEMIES!

We just heard Jesus's command to love our enemies. Fr. James Martin wrote about a priest who told this story during a homily:

“Now,” says the priest, “I'll bet that many of us feel as if we have enemies in our lives. So, raise your hands if you have many enemies.” And a few people raise their hands. “Now raise your hands if you have only a few enemies.” And about half as many people raise their hands. “Now raise your hands if you have only one or two enemies.” And even fewer people raised their hands. “See,” says the priest, “most of us feel like we have enemies.” Now raise your hands if you have no enemies at all.” Way in the back, an old man raises his hand and says, “I have no enemies whatsoever!” Delighted, the priest invites the man to the front of the church. “What a blessing!” the priest says. “How old are you?”

“I'm 98 years old, and I have no enemies.” Delighted, the priest responds, “What a wonderful Christian life you lead! Tell us all how it is that you have no enemies,” to which the old man replied: “All the scoundrels have died!”

The sad reality is that most of us do go through life with a few people we feel are our enemies. There is the person who hurt us and refuses to apologize...so we do not talk to them. At work, someone is jealous of us or angry at us. Many families have people who hold grudges for mysterious reasons. When Jesus tells us to love our enemies, how realistic is it? “Love” here does not mean warm fuzzy feelings. The Greek verb used by Matthew about the kind of love Jesus means is ‘agape.’ Accurately translated is “to care about,” “to be concerned about.” Agape is love as goodwill, benevolent love that cannot be conquered, a love that wills only the good for the person. Jesus had that kind of love when the Romans were killing him, and he is showing us the kind of love we need to have for everyone, even those who hurt us. The truth is Jesus gives Himself in agape love for all people, even those we think of as our enemies. Not only that, but Jesus counts on us to help them accept the love God offers. How can they know God's love if they do not experience it through us? The least we can do, and what Jesus wants us to do, is pray for them.

At the end of the first reading, St. Paul says: “. . . evaluate the genuineness of your love by your concern for others.” That means: All others, even enemies.

¡AMA A TUS ENEMIGOS!

Acabamos de escuchar el mandato de Jesús de amar a nuestros enemigos. Padre James Martin escribió sobre un sacerdote que contó esta historia durante una homilía:

“Ahora”, dice el sacerdote, “apuesto a que muchos de nosotros sentimos que tenemos enemigos en nuestras vidas. Así que levanta la mano si tienes muchos enemigos”. Y pocas personas levantan la mano. “Ahora levanta la mano si solo tienes unos pocos enemigos”. Y aproximadamente la mitad de las personas levantan la mano. “Ahora levanta la mano si solo tienes uno o dos enemigos”. Y aún menos personas levantaron la mano. “Mira”, dice el sacerdote, “la mayoría de nosotros sentimos que tenemos enemigos”. Ahora levanten la mano si no tienen enemigos en absoluto”. Allá atrás, un anciano levanta la mano y dice: “¡No tengo enemigos en absoluto!”. Encantado, el sacerdote invita al hombre al frente de la iglesia. “¡Que bendición!” dice el cura. “¿Cuántos años tienes?”

“Tengo 98 años y no tengo enemigos”. Encantado, el sacerdote responde: “¡Qué maravillosa vida cristiana llevas! Dinos a todos cómo es que no tienes enemigos.”, a lo que el anciano respondió: “¡Todos los sinvergüenzas han muerto!”

La triste realidad es que la mayoría de nosotros pasamos por la vida con algunas personas que sentimos que son nuestros enemigos. Está la persona que nos hirió y se niega a disculparse... entonces no hablamos con ellos. En el trabajo, alguien está celoso de nosotros o enojado con nosotros. Muchas familias tienen personas que guardan rencor por razones misteriosas.

Cuando Jesús nos dice que amemos a nuestros enemigos, ¿qué tan realista es? “Amor” aquí no significa sentimientos cálidos y confusos. El verbo griego usado por Mateo sobre el tipo de amor al que Jesús se refiere es ‘ágape’. La traducción precisa es “preocuparse por”, “estar preocupado por”. Ágape es amor como buena voluntad, amor benévolo que no puede ser vencido, amor que sólo quiere el bien de la persona. Jesús tenía ese tipo de amor cuando los romanos lo estaban matando, y nos está mostrando el tipo de amor que debemos tener por todos, incluso por aquellos que nos lastiman. La verdad es que Jesús se entrega en amor ágape a todas las personas, incluso a aquellas que consideramos nuestros enemigos. No solo eso, sino que Jesús cuenta con nosotros para ayudarlos a aceptar el amor que Dios les ofrece. ¿Cómo pueden conocer el amor de Dios si no lo experimentan a través de nosotros? Lo mínimo que podemos hacer, y lo que Jesús quiere que hagamos, es orar por ellos.

Al final de la primera lectura, San Pablo dice: “. . . evalúa la autenticidad de tu amor por tu preocupación por los demás.” Eso significa: Todos los demás, incluso los enemigos.
