## WE ARE KNOWN BY OUR FRUIT

This week, Jesus tells us that we must examine our own inner selves, our attitudes and dispositions, virtues and faults, rather than judging others. What is in our hearts comes out in what and how we speak. If our hearts are filled with kindness and compassion, those qualities will be evident in our speaking, just as beautiful, wholesome fruit comes only from healthy trees. And vice-versa. The Wisdom writer Sirach in the first reading agrees with this concept—that we will be judged by our words. Paul reminds us that the reward of discipleship is eternal life. Today's psalm of thanksgiving and praise reminds us of God's kindness and faithfulness, which we are to emulate in our thoughts, words, and deeds. We are known, each of us, by our own fruit.

**LENTEN REGULATIONS**

*Fasting* is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics between the ages of 18 years and 59 years (inclusive). On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.

*Abstinence* from meat is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. *Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent (and Good Friday) are days of abstinence.*

*Note: If a person is unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition.*

If you have a family member serving overseas, please let us know. We will publish their names in the bulletin to remind everyone to ask God's blessings on them, that they may return safely to their families. Let us join our prayers for peace and safety with yours. God's house has no dividing walls or closed doors. "I am the door," Jesus says. "Anyone who enters through me will be safe" (John 10:9). The more fully we enter into the house of love, the more clearly we see that we are there together with all humanity and that in and through Christ we are brothers and sisters, members of one family.

## HOW DO WE SEE AND LISTEN?

Sirach tells us: “One’s faults appear when one speaks.” What a warning! If we were smart, we would speak less. This goes well with Jesus’ questions: “Can a blind person guide a blind person? Will not both fall into a pit?” That sounds good, but how are we to apply it?

Suppose we considered Jesus’ idea from a unique perspective. What if we asked a blind person about what Jesus said? We just might get the response that a person born blind is the best teacher of the blind; one needs to be blind to understand the challenges blind people must overcome. (A sighted teacher might talk about a white cane; the non-sighted teacher realizes that the learner has no concept of whiteness.) This leads back to what Jesus taught in the Gospel of John: we need to admit our own areas of blindness. That, as they say in addiction programs, is the first step. Jesus tells us to remove the beam that blocks our vision, Pope Francis calls us to come together in dialogue to create a different world. Remembering Sirach’s advice, today’s readings suggest that we begin by speaking less and listening more. The very act of listening is an admission that we need to see through others’ eyes as well as our own. We are all blind in some way; admitting it will lead us to wonder and make us care with and for one another.

“For every tree is known by its own fruit.” Jesus states this principle in today’s Gospel. Just as a good tree bears good fruit and a bad tree bears bad fruit, so also the good steward produces good and an evil person evil. This is no coincidence. Our words and actions are outward expressions of what lies in our hearts. It is out of the “store of goodness in his heart” that the good person produces good and “out of the store of evil in his heart” that the evil person produces evil. How are our words and actions accurately reflecting what lies deep in our hearts?

## ¿CÓMO VEMOS Y ESCUCHAMOS?

Siracides nos dice: “Las faltas de uno aparecen cuando uno habla”. ¡Qué advertencia! Si fuéramos inteligentes, hablaríamos menos. Esto va bien con las preguntas de Jesús: “¿Puede un ciego guiar a otro ciego? ¿No caerán ambos en un hoyo?” Eso suena bien, pero ¿cómo vamos a aplicarlo?

Supongamos que consideramos la idea de Jesús desde una perspectiva única. ¿Qué pasa si le preguntamos a una persona ciega sobre lo que dijo Jesús? Es posible que obtengamos la respuesta de que una persona ciega de nacimiento es el mejor maestro de ciegos; uno necesita ser ciego para entender los desafíos que las personas ciegas deben superar. (Un maestro vidente podría hablar sobre un bastón blanco; el maestro no vidente se da cuenta de que el alumno no tiene concepto de blancura). Esto nos lleva de regreso a lo que Jesús enseñó en el Evangelio de Juan: debemos admitir nuestras propias áreas de ceguera. Ese, como dicen en los programas de adicciones, es el primer paso. Jesús nos dice que quitemos la viga que bloquea nuestra visión, el Papa Francisco nos llama a unirnos en diálogo para crear un mundo diferente. Recordando el consejo de Siracides, las lecturas de hoy sugieren que comencemos hablando menos y escuchando más. El mismo acto de escuchar es una admisión de que necesitamos ver a través de los ojos de los demás, así como de los nuestros. Todos somos ciegos de alguna manera; admitirlo nos llevará a preguntarnos y nos hará preocuparnos unos por otros.

“Porque todo árbol se conoce por su propio fruto.” Jesús declara este principio en el Evangelio de hoy. Así como el buen árbol da buenos frutos, y el árbol malo da frutos malos, así también el buen mayordomo produce bienes, y el malo, malos. Esto no es una coincidencia. Nuestras palabras y acciones son expresiones externas de lo que yace en nuestros corazones. Es de la “reserva de bondad en su corazón” que la persona buena produce el bien y “de la reserva de maldad en su corazón” que la persona mala produce el mal. ¿De qué manera nuestras palabras y acciones reflejan con precisión lo que yace en lo profundo de nuestros corazones?
