## IN THE DESERT

Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert for forty days, and then the devil tested him. Moses and the Israelites had been in the desert for forty years before being led to the land of milk and honey. There were times when they called out to God, sure that, as Saint Paul wrote to the Romans, "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." We sometimes spend time in the desert as well. Not a literal desert most of the time, but a desert in which it seems difficult to perceive God's presence, times when we face difficulty and are tempted to leave God's ways behind. On this First Sunday of Lent, Jesus shows us what to do in these moments: stand firm and trust in God.



## THE THREE TEMPTATIONS OF JESUS CHRIST.

The first involved food. After fasting for forty days in the desert, of course Jesus would be hungry. Satan tells Jesus to turn the stones into bread, Jesus tells him “Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.” (Matthew 4:11)

The second temptation Satan takes Jesus to the top of the Jewish Temple in Jerusalem and told Him to jump off. Satan quoted the Old Testament passage that stated, “On their hands they will bear you up, lest you strike your foot against a stone.” Jesus quoted again from Deuteronomy, saying, “You shall not put the Lord your God to the test.”

The third temptation, “The devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory” (Matthew 4:8). The devil then said he would give Jesus authority over all of these kingdoms if Jesus would worship him. Jesus refused, telling the devil to “Be gone”

(Matthew 4:10) again quoting Deuteronomy a third time, saying, “You shall worship the Lord your God and him only shall you serve.” The devil then left Him and angels served Him (Matthew 4:11).

When Satan tempts Jesus in the wilderness, Christ reveals a pattern for believers to follow. The temptation to sin or disobey God is a basic experience all people encounter. Jesus demonstrated the proper response—to resist with the help of God and his Word, which is our most powerful weapon to refute the lies of the Devil. The Lord’s clash with Satan in the wilderness occurred for our sake. It was part of God’s work of salvation, to show that he was tempted “in every way, just as we are” (Hebrews 4:15).

Cuando Satanás tienta a Jesús en el desierto, Cristo revela un modelo a seguir para los creyentes. 



This month we would like to address “Solidarity”, one of the 7 Themes of Catholic Social Teaching by partnering with our Hispanic ministry to bring support to the Cuban community. As St Paul reminds us as Christians we are “one body” and love of neighbor has global dimensions in our shrinking world. The Cuban population is under severe stress due to the collapse of their economy.

The *Peace and Justice Committee* in conjunction with the *Catholics for Cuba* Ministry

has begun an initiative to send to Cuba much needed over the counter medications, and we need your help.

**WHEN:** Saturday March 19 and Sunday, March 20.

**WHERE:** In the Narthex before and after each mass, donations will be collected.

**HOW:** The US Department of Transportation temporarily approved small airlines from Miami to deliver humanitarian aid to the island, and the Cuban government approved the flights. They have been happening since this September, and many deliveries have been made successfully. It costs \$9 per pound to ship supplies with the humanitarian flights.

**YOUR SUPPORT:** Your support is requested for this initiative in two ways:

1. The donation of funds to cover the shipment to Cuba, via Miami and Invicta Airlines.
2. The donation of medications as follows below.

**WHAT:** Sealed, unopened, over the counter medications and other medical

supplies. No prescription medications will be included. Requested items are:

- Vitamins for children and adults
- Low dose aspirin for cardiac patients.
- Anti-inflammatory medications for arthritis patients, such as Advil.
- Antacids such as Nexium, Prilosec, Gaviscon, Zantac, etc.
- Stomach medications such as Alka Seltzer, Tums, Milk of Magnesia, Pepto Bismol, etc.
- Triple antibiotic ointments such as Neosporin, as well as Cortisone Caladryl, etc.
- Cold and cough medications, and allergy medications.
- Diabetes glucometer test strips.
- Gauze, bandaids, and bandages.
- Hand sanitizer, thermometers, and medical face masks.






