THE MESSAGE OF CHRIST'S LOVE

From the proclamation of the Gospel at the beginning of the liturgy, we know that today is different, not only because we hear two Gospel passages, or because we hold palms and move in procession. Today begins Holy Week, a time set apart, a week in which to listen, pray, reflect, and take to heart the truth of Christ's passion, crucifixion, death, and ultimately, resurrection. It takes a week, and a lifetime, to truly hear the message of Christ's love. It is difficult for us to comprehend that Jesus willingly sacrificed himself, so we must hear the story again and again. Let this week be for us a new moment of faith in which we, together with the criminal who was crucified with Christ, cry out, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."

PALM SUNDAY MEANINGS

- ✿ Palm Sunday commemorates the entrance of Christ into Jerusalem (Matthew 21:1–9), when palm branches were in his path, before his arrest on Holy Thursday and his crucifixion on Good Friday. It thus marks the beginning of Holy Week, the final week of Lent.
- ✿ The palm branch is a symbol of victory, triumph, peace, and eternal life.
- ✿ The word hosanna is from Hebrew and related to Aramaic meaning save, rescue, savior.
- ✿ Jesus wanted to let his disciples know that he was not sending them on a “go-for” mission—the equivalent of a modern-day Starbucks run. Little did these two disciples know that their task was critical to the Palm Sunday event.
- ✿ Instead of Jesus riding on a horse which symbolizes physical force and victory in a battle, he was riding on a donkey which symbolizes humble service, a symbol of peace. In other words, by riding on a donkey, Jesus is bringing forth a message of peace that comes from God to His people.

- ✿ El Domingo de Ramos conmemora la entrada de Cristo en Jerusalén (Mateo 21:1–9), cuando las palmas estaban en su camino, antes de su arresto el Jueves Santo y su crucifixión el Viernes Santo. Por lo tanto, marca el comienzo de la Semana Santa, la última semana de Cuaresma.
- ✿ La rama de palma es símbolo de victoria, triunfo, paz y vida eterna.
- ✿ La palabra hosanna es del hebreo y está relacionada con el arameo que significa salvar, rescatar, salvador.
- ✿ Jesús quería que sus discípulos supieran que no los estaba enviando a una misión de “ir a por”—el equivalente en nuestra vida moderna a una carrera de Starbucks. Poco sabían estos dos discípulos que su tarea era crítica para el evento del Domingo de Ramos.
- ✿ En lugar de Jesús montado en un caballo que simboliza la fuerza física y la victoria en una batalla, estaba montado en un burro que simboliza el servicio humilde, un símbolo de paz. En otras palabras, al montar en un burro, Jesús está trayendo un mensaje de paz que viene de Dios a su pueblo.

A tradition of those with Polish and Eastern European ancestry is the traditional blessing of Easter Food Baskets on Holy Saturday. In earlier times, the priest came to people's homes to bless the food, but today, the people go to church for these blessings and prayers. It has been a tradition at St. Agnes for people to bring baskets of food that they will serve on Easter to be blessed in the church in English and Polish at 2 p.m. on Holy Saturday.

There is a symbolic meaning to some of the foods included in the baskets; Bread for new life with Jesus seen as the "Bread of Life;" Sausage or ham for health, prosperity and the belief in the Resurrection; horseradish/vinegar to ensure physical strength and remind us of the agony suffered by Christ on the cross; and salt for wisdom, justice and purification. Candles also signify Jesus as the Light of the world and finally, eggs indicate hope, new life and Jesus' Resurrection which may or may not be colored. These are just a few! We invite you to join us and find meaning in this beautiful tradition!

The Easter Egg Hunt takes place immediately following the Food Blessing for ages 1-10 (older children are welcome to help).

Each participant is asked to bring 12 filled plastic eggs (no chocolate) & one non-perishable item for St. Vincent DePaul food bank.
