

## DIFFICULTY, SURVIVAL, AND GLORY

In Revelation, John the Evangelist tells us what we can expect as followers of the risen Jesus: distress, endurance, and a kingdom. Although we are only eight days into our fifty-day Easter feasting, we cannot ignore the distress weighing down our daily lives. Jesus' resurrection does not erase individual suffering, but his glorious triumph over death cultivates endurance in our hearts. We remember that Jesus did not spare himself, and we ask for the strength to endure as he did. Imitating Christ helps us grow as members of God's royal family. As beloved citizens of the Kingdom of God, we recognize our kinship with all people. Peter demonstrates his care for others as he heals multitudes of broken, suffering people. In the Gospel, Thomas accepts his own spiritual healing when Jesus helps him to believe. In times of difficulty, survival, and glory, we borrow Thomas' declaration of faith:

"My Lord and my God!"

## DIVINE MERCY - SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER

Today, the Second Sunday of Easter, is Divine Mercy Sunday. Our Gospel reading from St. John is often called the story of “Doubting Thomas,” but the passage involves so much more than the encounter with the skeptical apostle. It is rich with lessons of Christ’s mercy to all, including an encouraging word from our Lord especially for us, His modern-day disciples.

While Thomas traditionally takes all the bad rap for his doubts, we see that none of the Apostles were at their best when Christ first appeared to them after His resurrection. They were in hiding, cowering behind a locked door, paralyzed by fear and doubt.

But Jesus appeared right in their midst despite the lock on the door. Was it to rebuke them for their lack of faith? Quite the contrary.

He comes on a mission of mercy. He comes to offer them peace and the restoration of their relationship with Him. And even more, He commissions them to become ministers of His mercy, by giving them authority to forgive sins. At that moment Christ gives to all of us the supreme gift of mercy — the sacrament of Reconciliation. What a precious and powerful gift!

This Sunday is a perfect time to reflect on how well we make use of this gift. Do we really appreciate its healing power? Could we become better stewards of this gift by going to Confession more often? We must also reflect on how well we extend mercy to others as Jesus did to Thomas that day.

Let us commit ourselves to becoming faithful disciples and stewards of Christ’s mercy. We will be those very ones to whom Jesus gave a “shout out” during His encounter with Thomas: “Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed” — in His merciful love.

## DIVINA MISERICORDIA - SEGUNDO DOMINGO DE PASCUA

Hoy, Segundo Domingo de Pascua, es el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. Nuestra lectura del Evangelio de San Juan a menudo se llama la historia de “Tomás el incrédulo”, pero el pasaje implica mucho más que el encuentro con el apóstol escéptico. Está lleno de lecciones de la misericordia de Cristo para todos, incluida una palabra de aliento de nuestro Señor, especialmente para nosotros, sus discípulos modernos.

Si bien Tomás tradicionalmente toma toda la mala reputación por sus dudas sobre él, vemos que ninguno de los Apóstoles estaba en su mejor momento cuando Cristo se les apareció por primera vez después de su resurrección. Estaban escondidos, acobardados detrás de una puerta cerrada, paralizados por el miedo y la duda.

Pero Jesús apareció justo en medio de ellos a pesar de la cerradura de la puerta. ¿Fue para reprenderlos por su falta de fe? Todo lo contrario.

Viene en una misión de misericordia. Él viene a ofrecerles la paz y la restauración de su relación con Él. Y más aún, los comisiona para que se conviertan en ministros de su misericordia de parte de él, dándoles autoridad para perdonar los pecados. En ese momento, Cristo nos da a todos nosotros el don supremo de la misericordia: el sacramento de la Reconciliación. ¡Qué regalo tan precioso y poderoso!

Este domingo es un momento perfecto para reflexionar sobre el buen uso que hacemos de este don. ¿Realmente apreciamos su poder curativo? ¿Podemos ser mejores administradores de este don si nos confesamos con más frecuencia? También debemos reflexionar sobre qué tan bien extendemos la misericordia a los demás como Jesús lo hizo con Tomás ese día.
