MAKING ALL THINGS NEW

Although we are five full weeks into the celebration of Easter, today's readings focus on newness. Our Easter food leftovers may be long gone, but the readings insist on every moment's freshness in the risen Jesus. The Acts of the Apostles depicts Paul and Barnabas reflecting on all the innovative work that God has done with them. They have traveled hundreds of miles, introducing faith in Jesus Christ to all who listen, even Gentiles. For the dutiful Jewish scholar Paul, preaching to Gentiles is a completely unique development. Jesus calls Paul, and us, not to be afraid of new challenges: as John the Evangelist reports in Revelation, Jesus promises to "make all things new." In the Gospel reading, Jesus even gives us a new commandment. The Hebrew Scriptures overflow with commandments, but Jesus knows we need one more, perfect mission: "love one another."





CHRIST IS RISEN! INDEED

He is risen! If you are thinking this greeting comes a little late, since Easter Sunday was April 17, think again. As Catholic Christians, we celebrate the Easter season for seven weeks, until the fires of Pentecost once again inflame our hearts on June 5. Indeed, how could we not continue to celebrate this event that has changed everything for us? It is easy to slip into a cultural way of thinking about our great feasts. Many people have the Christmas tree taken down at the end of New Year’s Day, rather than waiting for Epiphany

But the Christian steward is aware of the beauty and meaning of the seasons in the liturgical calendar. The Easter season remains a special time for recommitment to the Lord. One word for this period is “mystagogia,” and those who were newly baptized at the Great Easter Vigil are especially familiar with this term. It means that we delve more deeply into the mystery of our faith. But exploring this mystery is not just an endeavor for new Christians. As we prepare for Pentecost, we prayerfully examine what

the Resurrection means in our own lives. For Christian stewards, it is a time to reevaluate how faith in the Risen Lord informs every aspect of our lives – how we labor, how we play, the way we pray, how we allocate our resources, where we spend our time, how we love, how we extend our compassion to others. If Christ is truly risen – an astounding and life-altering belief – then this Easter time brings immense joy and a continuing desire to know the Risen Lord. The Scripture readings of the season are especially helpful. We hear once again the stories of the appearances of Jesus to his friends; how often they failed, initially, to recognize him in his glory. The Acts of the Apostles tell us of the struggles and the excitement of the new community of believers. We spent forty days in the penitential season of Lent. Now, we embark on fifty days of joyous celebration. Let us experience this joy throughout the Easter season, so that when we celebrate Pentecost, we may truly find our hearts on fire with the Holy Spirit.

¡CRISTO HA RESUCITADO! EN VERDAD RESUCITO

¡Él ha resucitado! Si estás pensando que este saludo llega un poco tarde, ya que el domingo de Pascua fue el 17 de abril, piénsalo de nuevo. Como cristianos católicos, celebramos el tiempo pascual durante siete semanas, hasta que el fuego de Pentecostés vuelva a encender nuestros corazones el 5 de junio. En efecto, ¿cómo no seguir celebrando este acontecimiento que lo ha cambiado todo para nosotros? Es fácil caer en una forma cultural de pensar acerca de nuestras grandes fiestas. Muchas personas desmontan el árbol de Navidad al final del día de Año Nuevo, en lugar de esperar a la Epifanía.

Pero el mayordomo cristiano es consciente de la belleza y el significado de las estaciones en el calendario litúrgico. La temporada de Pascua sigue siendo un tiempo especial para renovar el compromiso con el Señor. Una palabra para este período es “mistagogia”, y los recién bautizados en la Gran Vigilia Pascual están especialmente familiarizados con este término. Significa que profundizamos más en el misterio de nuestra fe. Pero explorar este misterio no es solo un esfuerzo para los nuevos cristianos. Mientras nos preparamos para Pentecostés, examinamos en oración lo que significa la Resurrección en nuestra propia vida. Para los mayordomos cristianos, es un momento para reevaluar cómo la fe en el Señor resucitado informa cada aspecto de nuestras vidas: cómo trabajamos, cómo actuamos, cómo oramos, cómo distribuimos nuestros recursos, dónde pasamos nuestro tiempo, cómo amamos, cómo extendemos nuestra compasión a los demás. Si Cristo realmente resucitó (una creencia asombrosa y que cambia la vida), entonces este tiempo de Pascua trae una inmensa alegría y un deseo continuo de conocer al Señor resucitado. Las lecturas bíblicas de la temporada son especialmente útiles. Escuchamos una vez más las historias de las apariciones de Jesús a sus amigos; cuántas veces fallaron, inicialmente, en reconocerlo en su gloria. Los Hechos de los Apóstoles nos hablan de las luchas y el entusiasmo de la nueva comunidad de creyentes. Pasamos cuarenta días en el tiempo penitencial de Cuaresma. Ahora, nos embarcamos en cincuenta días de alegre celebración. Experimentemos esta alegría a lo largo del tiempo pascual, para que cuando celebremos Pentecostés, encontremos verdaderamente nuestro corazón ardiendo con el Espíritu Santo.
