DISCIPLESHIP'S COSTS

In today's first reading, God tells the prophet Elijah to prepare Elisha to succeed him. Succeeding Elijah will be no easy task; he has spent his life facing threats from the kings he has confronted about their infidelity to the God of Israel. The psalm illustrates the emotional and spiritual distress that the prophets' steadfast faithfulness to God brought them. Paul's description of the Christian's freedom from the law as opposed to "the desire of the flesh" puts this struggle at the very heart of Christian identity. The reading from Luke's Gospel recounts Jesus' decision to journey toward Jerusalem, where he knows he will meet his earthly fate. Following Jesus—like succeeding Elijah as prophet—will now become more difficult. Unlike his calls to the first disciples, Jesus encounters those who are not ready or are not strong enough to journey with him.

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 10: 1-12, 17-20

We have now begun "The Travel Narrative" in Luke's Gospel. It begins with the 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time in the 9th Chapter of Luke's Gospel, and will continue until the 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time.

Now on the way to Jerusalem, Jesus forms his disciples about what it means to be a disciple, and he forms them with the human qualities expected and necessary for real disciples. So much of our lives and our identity gets based on what we do. Our lives and our worth get measured by what we earn, where we work, and what we accomplish. We are always tempted to think of discipleship in terms of a task, something to do. If that is the case, we have reduced being a disciple to just one more thing "to do". What we can discover in the weeks to come is that discipleship is more about who we are than what we do. Who are disciples? Poor. Notice how Jesus sends them out, with nothing. The consequence of that (notice how they come back) is Joy because they are free of anxiety and worry about things that have nothing to do with who they are. In the weeks to come we can discover how disciples live. So far, they are poor and joyful.



FROM EASTER TO PENTECOST: A STEWARDSHIP QUESTION

For those immersed in the secular world, Easter is long over. The pastel bunnies, the chocolate eggs, the color-splashed jellybeans which appeared in the marketplace so temptingly just as Christians were beginning the fasting of Lent, have long been swept from the store shelves to be replaced in anticipation of the next marketable holiday. For the Christian steward, how backward this all seems. Yes, we believe that the Paschal mystery and the life-changing events of Easter are not over. They are not an end but a triumphal beginning, and they have altered us in a quite radical way.

The mystery and miracle of Easter challenge us to live as different people, as people of the Resurrection. What does this mean? For those new Catholics who participated in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA), a period of mystagogy helps to understand this mystery. Indeed, this ancient Greek word means “to lead through the mysteries.” During mystagogia, many parishes introduce their new members to service in a quite practical way. Here are the ministries of the parish; here are the charities we support; here are the needs of our community and our congregation. How do you choose to live out your faith in the Resurrection in a quite tangible and authentic way? How do your gifts fit into our needs? However, this is a question that the Easter season calls forth in all Christian stewards not just our newest members. We have lived through Lent and the Paschal mysteries, all the while trying to deepen a relationship with the person of Christ. It is as simple, yet as amazing and complex as that. The deeper the relationship grows, the more we become rooted in it,

the more this relationship with Christ comes to dominate our lives. We no longer compartmentalize Jesus; we hold him at our center. And the mysteries lead us to the fundamental question at the heart of all Christian stewardship, the question that Easter compels us to ask: How do I steward my resources – my time, my money, my abilities and gifts, my very life – so that they are in service to the Kingdom of God? It is not a part-time question. It is not a seasonal question that is swept off the shelf periodically. It is the basic question which the Easter season demands of us: Jesus, how do you want me to serve you? From Easter to Pentecost, this is an important stewardship question.

DE PASCUA A PENTECOSTÉS: UNA CUESTIÓN DE CORRESPONSABILIDAD

Para aquellos inmersos en el mundo secular, la Pascua ya pasó. Los conejitos color pastel, los huevos de chocolate, las gominolas salpicadas de colores que aparecían en el mercado tan tentadoramente justo cuando los cristianos comenzaban el ayuno de Cuaresma, han sido barridas de los estantes de las tiendas hace mucho tiempo para ser reemplazadas en anticipación de la próxima festividad comercial. Para el mayordomo cristiano, qué atrasado parece todo esto. Sí, creemos que el misterio pascual y los eventos de Pascua que cambian la vida no han terminado. No son un final sino un comienzo triunfal, y nos han alterado de una manera bastante radical.

El misterio y el milagro de la Pascua nos interpelan a vivir como personas diferentes, como personas de la Resurrección. ¿Qué significa esto? Para aquellos nuevos católicos que participaron en el Rito de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos (RICA), un período de mistagogia ayuda a comprender este misterio. De hecho, esta antigua palabra griega significa “conducir a través de los misterios”. Durante la mistagogia, muchas parroquias introducen a sus nuevos miembros al servicio de una manera bastante práctica. Aquí están los ministerios de la parroquia; aquí están las organizaciones benéficas que apoyamos; aquí están las necesidades de nuestra comunidad y nuestra congregación. ¿Cómo eliges vivir tu fe en la Resurrección de una manera bastante tangible y auténtica? ¿Cómo encajan sus dones en nuestras necesidades? Sin embargo, esta es una pregunta que la temporada de Pascua suscita en todos los administradores cristianos, no solo en nuestros miembros más nuevos. Hemos vivido la Cuaresma y los misterios pascuales, tratando todo el tiempo de profundizar una relación con la persona de Cristo. Es tan simple, pero tan sorprendente y complejo como eso. Cuanto más profunda crece la relación, más nos enraizamos en ella,

más esta relación con Cristo llega a dominar nuestras vidas. Ya no compartimentamos a Jesús; lo mantenemos en nuestro centro. Y los misterios nos llevan a la pregunta fundamental en el corazón de toda la corresponsabilidad cristiana, la pregunta que la Pascua nos obliga a hacernos: ¿Cómo administro mis recursos, mi tiempo, mi dinero, mis habilidades y dones, mi propia vida, para que estén al servicio del Reino de Dios? No es una cuestión de medio tiempo. No es una cuestión de temporada que se barre del estante periódicamente. Es la pregunta fundamental que nos exige el tiempo pascual: Jesús, ¿cómo quieres que te sirva? Desde Pascua hasta Pentecostés, esta es una cuestión importante de mayordomía. Por Gretchen Filz
