Would you leave ninety-nine in the desert in order to find one lost sheep? In the parable, Jesus is showing us the depths of God's love, the illogical, incredible love God has for each of us. GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Twenty-fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time
Luke 16: 1-13

Disciples of Jesus, if they are wise will use everything they have for the sake of the Kingdom, and here is the virtue proposed next weekend, Wisdom. Wise disciples know what is of lasting value and what is fleeting, and they know that they can only serve one master and everything they have must be used in that service. There is a clever kind of far-seeing, and focused vision on what lies ahead that moves a true disciple to manage goods in ways appropriate to the Kingdom of God. It means faithful attention to frequent and familiar tasks of each day no matter how small they may seem. The one faithful with Nichols and dimes is the one to be trusted with the big account. Yet, it is easy to be indifferent toward small obligations while sincerely believing oneself fully trustworthy in major matters, but that is not Gospel Wisdom. Disciples never forget what lies ahead, but that does not prompt fear nor anxiety as much as it inspires wisdom and loyalty. They never forget: "Whoever is faithful in little things is faithful in bigger ones."



UPDATE FROM THE OPERATIONS MANAGER DESK

Dear Parishioners,

The last few years have brought extraordinary challenges to our St. Agnes Parish family and community. In spite of these, our parish continues to thrive. Your faithfulness and generosity have been exceptional during these difficult times, and we are most grateful.


The circumstances of the last few years have invited us to focus on what is most important. It has also allowed us to reflect on/identify areas that we needed to change and improve. In a parish that has 22 staff members and more than 5,000 families representing great diversity, it is critical that we ensure that we are being good stewards of the resources God has provided us through you to accomplish His mission.

Some of the improvements that have taken place in recent years include upgrading the interior lights in the Church to more efficient and long-lasting LED. Taking electricity and maintenance costs into account, this change will save the parish \$20,470 annually.

The COVID-19 pandemic prompted us to upgrade our audio-visual system, ensuring a better live stream experience. We also upgraded our antiquated wiring to fiber optic cables to eliminate disruptions and increase our bandwidth. These new lines, installed by Xfinity, guarantee 99.9% reliability and the best speeds in the industry. Our 15-year-old sound system was also failing, and we took the opportunity to upgrade that as well. We are currently working on similar improvements in the chapel. Our online Masses received more than 83,200 views through the first half of this year, and we hope you agree that these expenditures were well worth it.

Online giving continues to thrive with gifts coming from 28 states as well as Canada and Latin America. Looking back at the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2022, our secure online giving is on pace to grow by 5% over 2021. The chart below shows that St. Agnes has a total of 66% of its givers contributing online and 12% of those have scheduled recurring donations. We encourage you to take advantage of the convenience of recurring donations. Those using envelopes consist of 22% of the total givers, and we have 12% of total givers still putting "cash in the basket". The downside of doing this is that we have no record of who is making this donation which makes it difficult when services are requested. We are so very grateful for everyone's continued support and we encourage those who are giving cash, to register with the Parish and/or give online or begin using the envelopes provided.

The Parish Financial Report for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2022, shows that we ended the year with a surplus of \$1,009,015. While the numbers look great, we anticipate the need to update our deferred maintenance goals. Given current market conditions and record inflation, we believe a 10-15% increase is necessary, bringing our deferred maintenance goal from the current \$1,235,100 to \$1,420,365. That would mean a \$302,288 shortfall in the funds necessary for ongoing improvements, planned repairs, and unforeseen expenses. In fact, we are currently looking ahead at the following projects/upgrades:

- New Parish Center lobby/hallway flooring (In-Progress) - \$24,000
- Chapel Sound and Audio-Visual Upgrade - \$22,700
- Church/Chapel/Parish Center Carpet Cleaning - \$7,700
- Church/Chapel Floor Resurface/Polish (Due June 2023) - \$21,000

Thanks to your generous support, even during these difficult times, St. Agnes has been able to contribute \$230,411 for Catholic education in the form of tuition assistance to needy families and school support. An additional \$352,797 supported other local Catholic groups and organizations dedicated to helping the needy in our community, including our sister parish, Jesus the Worker in Ft. Myers.

The details of this year's Parish Annual Report are a testament to the good fruits of our parish community. Through your support to St. Agnes, you have continued to positively impact the lives of so many people. Our faith and complete confidence in Jesus Christ will help us to get through this and any future difficulties. Let us continue to proclaim the Good News of love, compassion, and mercy to others ... just like Jesus taught us.

ACTUALIZACION DEL GERENTE DE OPERACIONES

Estimados feligreses,

Los últimos años han traído muchos desafíos y dificultades para nuestra familia y comunidad de la Parroquia de St. Agnes. A pesar de esto, nuestra parroquia continúa prosperando. Su fidelidad y generosidad han sido excepcionales durante estos tiempos difíciles, y estamos muy agradecidos.


Las circunstancias de los últimos años nos han invitado a centrarnos en lo más importante. También nos ha permitido reflexionar sobre áreas que necesitábamos cambiar y mejorar. En una parroquia que tiene 22 miembros del personal y más de 5,000 familias que representan una gran diversidad, es fundamental que nos aseguremos de ser buenos administradores de los recursos que Dios nos ha proporcionado a través de usted para cumplir su misión.

Algunas de las mejoras que se han llevado a cabo en los últimos años incluyen la actualización de las luces interiores de la Iglesia a LED, las cuales son más eficientes y duraderos. Tomando en cuenta los costos de electricidad y mantenimiento, este cambio le ahorrará a la parroquia \$20,470 al año.

La pandemia de COVID-19 nos llevó a actualizar nuestro sistema de audiovisual, lo que garantiza una mejor experiencia de transmisión en vivo. También hemos actualizado los cables anticuados de la parroquia y hicimos la transición a cables de fibra óptica para eliminar interrupciones y aumentar nuestra banda internet. Estas nuevas líneas, instaladas por Xfinity, garantizan un 99.9% de confiabilidad y las mejores velocidades de la industria. Nuestro sistema de sonido de 15 años también estaba fallando y aprovechamos la oportunidad para actualizarlo. Actualmente estamos trabajando en mejoras similares en la capilla. Nuestras Misas en línea recibieron más de 83,200 visitas durante la primera mitad de este año, y esperamos que esté de acuerdo en que estos gastos valieron la pena.

Las donaciones en línea continúan prosperando con donaciones provenientes de 28 estados, así como de Canadá y América Latina. En el año fiscal que finalizó el 30 de junio de 2022, nuestras donaciones seguras en línea están en camino de crecer un 5% sobre el año anterior 2021. La gráfica a continuación muestra que St. Agnes tiene un total del 66 % de sus donantes contribuyendo en línea y el 12% de aquellos han programado donaciones recurrentes. Lo alentamos a que aproveche la conveniencia de las donaciones recurrentes. Aquellos que usan sobres consisten en el 22% del total de donantes, y tenemos un 12% del total de donantes que aún ponen "efectivo en la canasta". La desventaja de hacer esto es que no tenemos registro de quién está haciendo esta donación, lo cual trae dificultad cuando se solicitan servicios o cartas de inmigración. Estamos muy agradecidos por el apoyo continuo de todos y alentamos a aquellos que están dando dinero en efectivo a registrarse en la Parroquia y/o dar en línea o comenzar a usar los sobres proporcionados.

El informe financiero de la parroquia para el año fiscal que finalizó el 30 de junio de 2022 muestra que terminamos el año con un superávit de \$1,009,015. Aunque los números se ven muy bien, estamos anticipando la necesidad de actualizar nuestros objetivos de mantenimiento diferido. Dadas las condiciones actuales del mercado y la inflación en la economía, creemos que es necesario un aumento del 10-15 %, elevando nuestra meta de mantenimiento diferido de los \$1,235,100 actuales a \$1,420,365. Eso significaría un déficit de \$302,288 en los fondos necesarios para mejoras continuas, reparaciones planificadas y gastos imprevistos. De hecho, actualmente estamos pensando en los siguientes proyectos/actualizaciones:

- Nuevo vestíbulo/piso de pasillo del Centro Parroquial (en progreso) - \$24,000
- Actualización de sonido y audiovisual de la capilla - \$22,700
- Limpieza de alfombras de la iglesia/capilla/centro parroquial - \$7,700
- Revestimiento del piso de la iglesia/capilla/pulido (vence en junio de 2023) - \$21,000

Gracias a su generoso apoyo, incluso durante estos tiempos difíciles, St. Agnes ha podido contribuir \$230,411 para la educación católica en forma de asistencia para la matrícula de familias necesitadas y apoyo escolar. \$352,797 adicionales apoyaron a otros grupos y organizaciones católicas locales dedicadas a ayudar a los necesitados de nuestra comunidad, incluida nuestra parroquia hermana, Jesús Obrero en Ft. Myers.

Los detalles del Informe Anual Parroquial de este año son un testimonio de los buenos frutos de nuestra comunidad parroquial. A través de su apoyo a St. Agnes, ha continuado impactando positivamente las vidas de tantas personas. Nuestra fe y total confianza en Jesucristo nos ayudarán a superar esta y futuras dificultades. Sigamos proclamando las Buenas Nuevas de amor, compasión y misericordia a los demás... tal como Jesús nos enseñó.



Please continue to join me in prayer for a greater appreciation of the sacredness of all human life. May God bless you for your dedication and generosity!






