GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Twenty-eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 17: 11-19

Luke will propose a distinction next week between the nine and the one. It is a distinction between physical healing and spiritual healing. Notice that with those healed physically there is no mention of their salvation.

On the other hand, the one who returns to Jesus acknowledging what God had done for him is the one saved by faith. Because of his gratitude he was able to experience salvation beyond his cure. It is Gratitude as an essential virtue that Jesus puts before us now. Faith is confirmed by the witness of gratitude. Without it, there is no assurance of Salvation. These disciples recognize what God has done for them, and they return again and again to the feet of the master and "speak his praises" as the Gospel describes it. This is public recognition, please take note. It is not something the leper does quietly at home. This is exactly why we get ourselves to church in a public place. Disciples are grateful in an open, public way. The disciple of Jesus is found at the master's feet giving praise and thanks. This is a way of life. It is not a passing emotion. Gratitude is contagious.

ARE WE OBLIVIOUS TO THE WORLD AROUND US?

In last week’s Gospel, the main point was complacency. All of us are susceptible to getting involved in our own little world and tuning out those around us. We get caught up in our little patterns of living and learn to focus our attention on the things that concern us, and tune out the things that do not concern us. We view the world through a lens of “what does this have to do with me?” The Lord Jesus is trying to call our attention to the fact that we are all our brother’s keeper. We should be just as concerned about the needs of those around us, as we are with our own. In fact, which was the second great commandment that Jesus gave us “to love your neighbor, as you love yourself”. This week, we could try to notice those around us a little more than usual, especially the people we live and work with every day. That includes the clergy and religious in our lives too. The people that are closest to us are often the easiest to overlook when they are suffering, because they are so familiar to us. Things like suicides and divorce can sometimes be prevented by talking to one another more and being involved in one another’s lives, even if it is not a close family member or friend. Teenagers and young people are also especially vulnerable to suffering and the adults in their lives may not even notice it. This week let us notice those around us a little more than usual and see if there is anything we can do to help alleviate some of their suffering.

This year, Florida voters have the privilege and freedom to participate in voting for candidates who have come forward to serve their communities. November 8, 2022 is General Election Day.

The following offices will be decided:

- Federal: One of two Florida U.S. Senate seats and all 28 U.S. Representatives in Florida's Congressional Delegation.
- State: Governor of Florida, all 40 State Senators and all 120 State Representatives. Please note that some Florida legislative candidates have been elected with no opposition.

Before voting, Catholics are called to consider a wide range of issues important to the common good, weighing each according to its moral importance. It is beneficial to research the ballot ahead of time and gather the facts for every proposal and race. This guide offers information about Catholic teaching and questions regarding current issues to assist voters in evaluating candidate positions or political party platforms. 

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

A Groundbreaking Ceremony for the Vanderbilt Beach Road Extension Project took place on Tuesday, September 20th at St. Agnes. The project includes a new six-lane divided highway from east Collier Boulevard to Wilson Boulevard and includes new bike lanes and a shared-use path. A new two-lane undivided roadway will go from Wilson Boulevard to 16th Street NE allowing for future expansion to an ultimate 6-lane roadway. The intention is to prepare for future growth in Golden Gates Estates and to help relieve congestion on other arterial roadways and accommodate future traffic volumes. The project is expected to take three years, concluding in the summer of 2025.

The construction will affect our main church exit. We will no longer be able to turn left onto Vanderbilt Beach Rd. or exit straight across to Weber Blvd. Instead, all traffic will exit with a right turn and make a U-turn at Collier Blvd. Additionally,



a new exit will be built at the east end of our southeast parking lot onto Vanderbilt Beach Rd. that will permit a left turn onto Weber Blvd. as well as a U-turn onto Vanderbilt Beach Rd. This was negotiated with the help of the Diocesan Lawyers, Building Office, and consultants. Please pray for the safety of construction workers and the guidance of engineers and planners, and for patience on our part as this project is completed to better serve the community.





The Church's ministries of healing, education, and social services bear witness to Jesus Christ and build up the common good. Church institutions are not mere providers of social services. They are expressions of Christian ministry dedicated to human flourishing.

We serve all people, without regard to race, sex, religion, or any other status, because God has imbued every person with inherent human dignity. Most Americans understand that mission-driven organizations should be free to operate in accordance with their missions. But a recent rule proposed by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) would prevent Catholic hospitals, clinics, assisted living facilities, and health care workers from carrying out their work. **HHS needs to hear your opinion by October 3rd!** Visit www.usccb.org/do-no-harm to learn more.

Section 1557 is the nondiscrimination provision of the Affordable Care Act. It is an important provision

that protects people from discrimination based on their sex in health care. But the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) has proposed a new rule interpreting Section 1557 in a way that would impose new mandates. According to the proposed rule, it would be considered discrimination for a health care worker, Catholic hospital, and like-minded individuals and institutions, to object outright to performing gender transition procedures, regardless of religious belief or clinical judgment. The proposed rule also suggests that the government may refuse to honor the right of health care workers and providers not to perform or participate in abortions. The proposed HHS Section 1557 rule could function as both an abortion mandate and a gender transition procedure mandate for health care workers. **Your comments can make a difference!** Health care workers and medical facilities must be free to conscientiously object to gender transition procedures and should not be forced to perform abortions.




