ETERNAL LIFE

What happens after we die? Most religions and philosophies provide some notion of this, but we are confounded by the mystery of it all. Today's readings give us a glimpse through the faith of martyrs and in the words of Jesus. In the Old Testament reading, the Maccabee brothers assert with total confidence that the God who gave them life would also raise them to eternal life. This was not universally accepted in ancient Israel. The Sadducees, who denied any resurrection of the dead, try to trap Jesus with a hypothetical riddle. Jesus, known for turning such things around, dismisses their unbelief, noting that even Moses knew that all are alive in God. Saint Paul tells the Thessalonians that we live in everlasting encouragement and hope, and Psalm 17 echoes this with words of faith that we will see God's face, waking in God's loving presence.

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

The Thirty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 21: 5-19

We like permanence, and like pretending that things will last a long time, and we get impatient when they wear out. Yet we live in an economy based upon obsolescence. For the Jews at the time of Jesus, that Temple he speaks of was beginning to suggest permanence. It must have been something, the biggest and the best of everything. Herod had doubled its size, and it was big before he started. You could see it from a long way off, and covered with gold, people had to shield their eyes the light was so intense. The suggestion from Jesus that it would come down was intolerable, unacceptable. It struck their very identity. Our identity is not in the things we have made or built; but in what we have become through our relationships with Christ Jesus and each other. Since we all die sooner or later, there is only one possible interpretation of the promise Jesus makes there in Jerusalem. It is the guarantee that no one can destroy us within, take away our faith or our integrity, or cause us to lose our eternity with God.



DISCIPLESHIP, STEWARDSHIP AND EVANGELIZATION

I have been influenced by the wisdom of Bishop Sylvester Ryan, bishop emeritus of Monterey, California, who often reminds us that stewardship and evangelization are two sides of the same coin. That coin is discipleship. Forming people who are aware of their call to grow as disciples is a dynamic and life-giving process. It can also be challenging, as is the call itself. Jesus' way is one that places demands upon us, and yet, as the United States bishops' pastoral letter on stewardship notes, it is also a way of joy and a life filled with meaning. Let us briefly explore these three interrelated calls:

Discipleship: While we are drawn into Christ's Body through the waters of baptism, many grow into a living relationship with Christ over many years. Once that relationship has been ignited, or re-ignited, people's lives are shaped by their faith and desire to grow in love of God and all that we believe as Christians. This process of ongoing conversion takes place within the community of faith. We need to create an environment in which those who are already on the journey of discipleship recognize their call to reach out to others, building bridges to living faith.

Stewardship: We are Christian stewards because we are followers of Jesus Christ. As the bishops' pastoral indicates clearly, "Stewardship is an expression of discipleship with the power to change how we understand and live out our lives." Through our lives as stewards, we embrace Christ's self-giving, sacrificial way of life.

Evangelization: When we are in love, we cannot help but share that love with others. That is the essence of evangelization. We share the love of God as good stewards of our faith, and our sharing has the potential to draw others into a new or deeper relationship with God in Jesus Christ, as disciples and stewards.

He sido influenciado por la sabiduría del obispo Sylvester Ryan, obispo emérito de Monterey, California, quien a menudo nos recuerda que la mayordomía y la evangelización son dos caras de la misma moneda. Esa moneda es el discipulado. Formar personas conscientes de su llamado a crecer como discípulos es un proceso dinámico y vivificante. También puede ser desafiante, como lo es la llamada en sí. El camino de Jesús es uno que nos impone demandas y, sin embargo, como señala la carta pastoral de los obispos de los Estados Unidos sobre la corresponsabilidad, también es un camino de alegría y una vida llena de significado. exploremos brevemente estas tres llamadas interrelacionadas:

Discipulado: Mientras somos atraídos al Cuerpo de Cristo a través de las aguas del bautismo, muchos crecen en una relación viva con Cristo durante muchos años. Una vez que esa relación se ha encendido o vuelto a encender, la vida de las personas se moldea por su fe y deseo de crecer en el amor a Dios y todo lo que creemos como cristianos. Este proceso de conversión continua tiene lugar dentro de la comunidad de fe. Necesitamos crear un entorno en el que aquellos que ya están en el camino del discipulado reconozcan su llamado a tender la mano a los demás, construyendo puentes para vivir la fe.

Mayordomía: Somos mayordomos cristianos porque somos seguidores de Jesucristo. Como lo indica claramente la pastoral de los obispos, "La corresponsabilidad es una expresión de discipulado con el poder de cambiar la forma en que entendemos y vivimos nuestras vidas". A través de nuestras vidas como mayordomos, adoptamos la forma de vida sacrificial y abnegada de Cristo.

Evangelización: Cuando estamos enamorados, no podemos evitar compartir ese amor con los demás. Esa es la esencia de la evangelización. Compartimos el amor de Dios como buenos administradores de nuestra fe, y nuestro compartir tiene el potencial de atraer a otros a una relación nueva o más profunda con Dios en Jesucristo, como discípulos y administradores.
