THE END OF DAYS

As we prepare for next Sunday's feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, we hear descriptions of dire and catastrophic events. Sometimes it seems as though we ourselves are living in the end times, when life as we currently know it will cease for everyone. In answer to what must have been a fearful question, Jesus does not sugarcoat his foretelling of future days. Nor does the Old Testament prophet Malachi flinch from his pronouncements upon an evil world. Saint Paul, still writing to the Thessalonians, warns them prophetically against succumbing to "The End Is Near" syndrome—indolence in the face of the final days. However, both Jesus and Malachi speak of the recompense for living a just life— healing and vindication. Our Psalm 98, typically associated with Christmastime, helps us to rejoice for the King who is coming to rule with justice.

GOSPEL REFLECTION FOR NEXT SUNDAY

Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe
Luke 23: 35-43

Now it is time to set aside Luke’s Gospel and pick up Matthew as Advent begins. It has been a long journey to Jerusalem this year that took us to the home of Zachariah and to the Temple where Jesus preached his final sermon before turning his head toward the cross. As Luke finishes his story, we begin to see that much of it has been about power. Our history is a long list of Power’s abuses. Yet, this feast next week gives us another vision of Power, the power of love. It is a power for service. It is not power to come down from the cross, call from a tomb, restore sight or hearing. It is power over the human heart. Only Luke’s Gospel tells of these two men, and by placing them in the great contest of power, Luke shifts the image slightly so that suddenly it is not about Jesus. He is not the only one who dies. He is not the only one who faces raw power. He is not the only one who looks death in the face. Those two men draw us into the picture as well. In them we see ourselves and all humanity. Now, the consequences of power used or abused are inescapable. At the end, there are only two choices, darkness or light, right or wrong, power or service, death of life.

NOVEMBER – A MONTH TO REFLECT ON GRATITUDE

“It is gratitude that ultimately asks one thing, but at a great price: fall extravagantly in love with what is given.” Those words were penned by a Jesuit priest, Pat Malone, a man who volunteered for service at Ground Zero after the 9/11 World Trade Center bombings, and who struggled with leukemia and associated complications before succumbing to the disease in his early fifties. A mystic, Father Malone endured, or as he described it, “was given” much suffering. He was also given love, as he was beloved by his parishioners at Creighton University’s parish, St. John’s, who put together a book of his homilies and writings following his death. During the month of November, those of us who live in the United States are focused on a major national holiday, Thanksgiving; the fundamental theme of which is “gratitude.” Gratitude is a foundational principle of Christian stewardship, so November is a wonderful time for stewards to contemplate giving thanks. But sometimes, there is a tendency to get distracted and the deeply spiritual aspect of thankfulness gets lost in the preoccupation with family, home, income – that we often take for granted but pause to acknowledge over the turkey and stuffing.

Father Malone’s words ask us to think much more radically about gratitude. How often are we grateful for “what is given?” Natural disasters have caused immense suffering globally. War and ethnic cleansing continue. Refugees swarm the planet in record-breaking numbers. Mindless violence haunts our streets. How do we fall in love with tragedy? Doesn’t this seem wrong? And in our own lives, troubles, and struggles, small and sometimes great, are seldom things for which we pause and give thanks. But as any good spiritual director will tell you, a fundamental question of our prayer lives must be: Where was God in this for you? How did you find God in this event? A good November exercise for Christian stewards would be to keep a 30-day journal of thankfulness. But do not just make it a list of the “good” stuff. Make it a review of the day in which, for better or worse, you found God guiding you through good times and bad. Father Malone suggests that falling in love – extravagantly – with what is given in your life will exact a great price. What does he mean? How might you be changed? What more ordinary ideas of thankfulness will you put aside as you learn to love your life and your struggle in, he given moment?

NOVIEMBRE: UN MES PARA REFLEXIONAR SOBRE LA GRATITUD

“Es la gratitud que al final pide una cosa, pero a un gran precio: enamorarse extravagantemente de lo que se da.” Esas palabras fueron escritas por el sacerdote jesuita, Pat Malone, un hombre que se ofreció como voluntario para el servicio en la Zona Cero después de los atentados del 11 de septiembre en el World Trade Center, y que luchó contra la leucemia y las complicaciones asociadas antes de sucumbir a la enfermedad a los 50 años. Un místico, el padre Malone soportó, o como él lo describió, “recibió” mucho sufrimiento. También recibió amor, ya que fue amado por sus feligreses en la parroquia St. John de la Universidad de Creighton, quienes copilaron un libro de sus homilias y escritos después de su muerte. Durante el mes de noviembre, aquellos de nosotros que vivimos en los Estados Unidos estamos concentrados en una importante fiesta nacional, el Día de Acción de Gracias; cuyo tema fundamental es la “gratitud”. La gratitud es un principio fundamental de la mayordomía cristiana, por lo que noviembre es un tiempo maravilloso para que los mayordomos contemplen dar gracias. Pero a veces, hay una tendencia a distraerse y el aspecto profundamente espiritual del agradecimiento se pierde en la preocupación por la familia, el hogar, los ingresos, que a menudo damos por sentado, pero nos detenemos a reconocer mientras comemos pavo y relleno.

Las palabras del padre Malone nos piden que pensemos mucho más radicalmente sobre la gratitud. ¿Con qué frecuencia estamos agradecidos por “lo que se nos da”? Los desastres naturales han causado un inmenso sufrimiento a nivel mundial. La guerra y la limpieza étnica continúan. Los refugiados pululan por el planeta en números récord. La violencia sin sentido acecha nuestras calles. ¿Cómo nos enamoramos con la tragedia? ¿No parece esto incorrecto? Y en nuestras propias vidas, los problemas y las luchas, pequeños y a veces grandes, rara vez son cosas por las que nos detenemos y damos gracias. Pero como cualquier buen director espiritual te dirá, una pregunta fundamental de nuestra vida de oración debe ser: ¿Dónde estaba Dios en esto para ti? ¿Cómo encontraste a Dios en este evento? Un buen ejercicio de noviembre para los mayordomos cristianos sería llevar un diario de agradecimiento de 30 días. Pero no se limite a hacer una lista de las cosas “buenas”. Haz que sea un repaso del día en el que, para bien o para mal, encontraste a Dios guiándote en las buenas y en las malas. El padre Malone sugiere que enamorarse, extravagantemente, de lo que se le da en la vida tendrá un gran precio. ¿Qué quiere decir? ¿Cómo podrías ser cambiado? ¿Qué ideas de agradecimiento más ordinarias dejarás de lado a medida que aprendas a amar tu vida y tu lucha en un momento dado?

IRA CHARITABLE ROLLOVER= GREAT OPPORTUNITY UNDER NEW TAX LAWS



Whether you itemize or not in 2022, this unique opportunity allows you to make a charitable contribution through a direct IRA transfer while reducing your adjusted gross income.

IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO MAKE A GIFT TO OUR PARISH USING YOUR IRA AND IF:

1. You are at least 70 ^{1/2} years old on the date you make your gift.
2. Your IRA is a traditional (some Roth IRA's may qualify).
3. You don't exceed your personal maximum of \$100,000 per year in qualified charitable distributions.

You will not have to report your distribution as income. It will be free of federal income tax, and it will count toward your required minimum distribution (RMD).

The best way for you to start is with your IRA custodian. Tell them you want to make a "qualified charitable distribution." In most cases you will only have to fill out a simple form.

VERY IMPORTANT! Your gift must go directly from your IRA to our Parish. If you receive the money first, then you will be taxed on it like any other distribution.

Example:

Bill has \$125,000 in a traditional IRA and would like to contribute \$5,000 as his yearly gift to his Parish. Upon hearing of the Charitable IRA Rollover opportunity, he directs the custodian of his IRA to transfer this amount not later than December 31, 2022 directly to the Parish as the family's 2022 gift. He will not be subject to income tax on the \$5,000 donation.

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

Formerly called Last Rites or Extreme Unction, this Sacrament is for those experiencing a serious illness, facing an operation or dying. Anointing of the Sick should be performed before death is imminent, when a person is conscious and able to receive comfort from the sacrament.

We make every effort to provide pastoral care and the sacrament of anointing to all who request it; however, families are encouraged to call sooner rather than later. If a loved one is at home and needs the sacrament, please call the office at 592-1949 to arrange for a priest to visit.

In the Hospital?

Please ask the nurse to contact the parish that serves the Hospital you are in for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.

This is the most efficient way to be sure you or your loved one will receive the sacrament. Be aware that because of HIPAA Privacy regulations, hospitals do not necessarily notify the parish regarding your hospitalization unless requested by the patient.
